Class 1 - 08:30 - Indoors - Pony Intro 70cm Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 70cm.

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £18.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £86.00. **Entry Fee = £14.00**

Class 2a - Indoors - Pony British Novice First Round

Rule 410. Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 80cm.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered Ponies in Grade JD and JC that have not won a total of 150 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13.

Qualifies for: Pony British Novice Championship Second Rounds.

Qualifying period 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Pony British Novice First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony British Novice First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

If combined with an open: In the event of 15 or more starters this class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £18.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £86.00. **Entry Fee = £14.00**

Class 2b - Indoors - Pony Intro 80cm Open

Rule 410. Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 80cm.

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £18.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £86.00. **Entry Fee = £14.00**

Class 3a - Indoors - Pony Discovery First Round

Rule 408. Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 300 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13.

Qualifies for: Pony Discovery Second Round.

Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify for: Those ponies which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Pony Discovery First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Discovery Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony Discovery First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £15.00, 5th: £15.00, Total: £95.00. **Entry Fee = £15.00**

Class 3b - Indoors - Pony Intro 90cm Open

Rule 408. Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £15.00, 5th: £15.00, Total: £95.00. **Entry Fee = £15.00**

Class 4 - Indoors - Blue Chip Pony Newcomers - First Round

Rule 406. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Blue Chip In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 500 Points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Blue Chip Pony Newcomers Second Round.

Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Newcomers Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). The winner of a particular Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £15.00, 5th: £15.00, Total: £95.00. **Entry Fee = £15.00**

Class 5 - Indoors - Pony Foxhunter/1.10m Open (both to Inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Qualifier)

Rule 404 & 417. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Pony Foxhunter First Round is for ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 700 Points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Pony Foxhunter Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Second Round irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). The winner of a particular competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification.

The Open Section is open to all. Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Foxhunter Section, ridden by Junior members who have not won more than a total of 350 Points in the previous calendar year are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification is pony/rider combination. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.10m Final.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £15.00, 5th: £15.00, Total: £95.00. **Entry Fee = £15.00**

Class 6a - 12:30 - Indoors - Dodson & Horrell 85cms National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round

Rule 318. Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 85cm.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League as of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying Period).

Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 85cms National Amateur Second Rounds.

Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 85cm National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 85cm National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 85cm Second Round competition. The winner of a particular 85cm National Amateur First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

THIS CLASS WILL NOT START BEFORE 12.30 DUE TO THE JUNIOR CLASSES RUNNING FIRST

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £17.00, 4th: £17.00, Total: £79.00. **Entry Fee = £17.00**

Class 7a - Indoors - Dodson & Horrell 95cms National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round

Rule 320. Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 95cm.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld.
Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying Period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 95cms National Amateur Second Rounds

Qualifying period: 1st September - 31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 95cm National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 95cm National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 95cm Second Round competition.

The winner of a particular 95cm National Amateur First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Class 7b - Indoors - Senior 95cm Open

Class 8a - Indoors - Dodson & Horrell 1.05m National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld.
Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 1.05m National Amateur Second Rounds.

Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 1.05m National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 1.05m National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 1.05m Second Round competition.

The winner of a particular 1.05m National Amateur First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £40.00, 3rd: £30.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £17.50, 6th: £17.50, Total: £175.00. **Entry Fee = £17.50**

Class 8b - Indoors - **Senior 1.05m Open**

Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.05m.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £40.00, 3rd: £30.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £17.50, 6th: £17.50, Total: £175.00. **Entry Fee = £17.50**

Class 9a - Indoors - **Dodson & Horrell 1.10m National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round**

Rule 324. Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 1.10m National Amateur Second Rounds.

Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 1.10m National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first, round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 1.10m National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 1.10m Second Round competition.

The winner of a particular 1.10m National Amateur First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £22.00, 5th: £18.00, Total: £150.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00**

Class 9b - Indoors - **Senior 1.10m Open**

Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £22.00, 5th: £18.00, Total: £150.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00**

Class 10 - Indoors - **National 1.15m Members Cup Qualifier**

Rule 294. Two Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.15m.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who are not listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2017.

Qualifies for: British Showjumping National Championships.

Qualification period: 1st June-31st May.

Numbers to qualify: Four double clears (subject to revision). Qualification is horse/rider combination.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £22.00, 5th: £18.00, Total: £150.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00**
