- CLASS 1 YEARLING** To be born in 2021, not to be exceeding 153cm at maturity. Colt, filly or gelding.
- CLASS 2 YOUNGSTOCK (TWO YEAR OLD)** To be born in 2020, not to be exceeding 153cm at maturity. Colt, filly or gelding.
- CLASS 3 YOUNGSTOCK (THREE YEAR OLD)** To be born in 2019, not to be exceeding 153cm at maturity. Colt, filly or gelding.
- CLASS 4 SHOW PONY/SHOW HUNTER PONY** Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Not exceeding 153cm. Any age.
- CLASS 5 BEST CONDITIONED** Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Not exceeding 153cm. Any age.
- CLASS 6 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS (EXCLUDING WELSH)** Open to In Hand Mountain and Moorland ponies who are registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor and Shetland. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Any age. All breeds must be shown in Natural State Only.
- CLASS 7 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS (EXCLUDING WELSH)** Open to In Hand Mountain and Moorland ponies who are registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of New Forest, Connemara, Dales, Fell and Highland. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Any age. All breeds must be shown in Natural State only.
- CLASS 8 WELSH SECTION A MARE, FILLY OR GELDING** Not exceeding 122cm. Any age.
- CLASS 9 WELSH SECTION A COLT OR STALLION** Not exceeding 122cm. Any age. Handler must be over the age of 18.
- CLASS 10 WELSH SECTION B MARE, FILLY OR GELDING** Not exceeding 138cm. Any age.
- CLASS 11 WELSH SECTION B COLT OR STALLION** Not exceeding 138cm. Any age. Handler must be over the age of 18.
- CLASS 12 WELSH SECTION C MARE, FILLY OR GELDING** Not exceeding 138cm. Any age.
- CLASS 13 WELSH SECTION C COLT OR STALLION** Not exceeding 138cm. Any age. Handler must be over the age of 18.
- CLASS 14 WELSH SECTION D MARE, FILLY OR GELDING** Exceeding 138cm. Any age.
- CLASS 15 WELSH SECTION D COLT OR STALLION** Exceeding 138cm. Any age. Handler must be over the age of 18.
- CLASS 16 COLOURED NATIVE/TRADITIONAL/COB** Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Not exceeding 153cm. Any age.
- CLASS 17 NON-NATIVE COLOURED** Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Not exceeding 153cm. Any age.
- CLASS 18 TRADITIONAL GYPSY COB** Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Not exceeding 153cm. Any age.

# RIDDEN PONIES

**Commencing at 8am prompt in the Main International Indoor Arena**

**CLASS 22 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LEAD REIN AND FIRST RIDDEN** Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh Section A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. Lead rein riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle with the lead rein attached to the noseband only. First ridden riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle. Rosettes will be awarded for each section.

**CLASS 23 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND JUNIOR RIDER FINAL** Open to ponies 4 years old and over. Open to registered and unregistered Welsh Section A, B, Exmoor, Dartmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section C, D, Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara and New Forest. Riders to be 15 years and under at time of entry and to be suitably mounted. Mare or gelding only. Class will be split into large and small breeds for the go round.

**CLASS 24 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS (INCLUDING WELSH)** Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies who are registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A's and B's. Stallion, mare or gelding. Rider to be suitably mounted. All breeds must be shown in Natural State only.

**CLASS 25 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS (INCLUDING WELSH)** Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies who are registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest and Welsh C's and D's. Stallion, mare or gelding. All breeds must be shown in Natural State only.

**CLASS 26 SHOW HUNTER/SHOW PONY LEAD REIN AND FIRST RIDDEN** Open to ponies 4 years old and over and not exceeding 122cm. Lead rein riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle with the lead rein attached to the noseband only. First ridden riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle. Rosettes will be awarded for each section. Mare or gelding only.

**CLASS 27 SHOW HUNTER PONY** Open to Show Hunter ponies 4 years old and over. Not exceeding 153cm. Stallion, mare or gelding. Riders not to have attained their **20th birthday before the 1st January** in the current year.

**CLASS 28 VETERAN (OVER 15 YEARS)** Pony to be born before 2007. Stallion, mare or gelding. Not exceeding 153cm.

**CLASS 29 OPEN COLOURED** Open to Piebald/Skewbald/Appaloosa/Palomino ponies 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cm. Stallion, mare or gelding.

**CLASS 30 TRADITIONAL GYPSY COB** Open to Traditional Gypsy Cob ponies 4 years old and over. Not exceeding 153cm. Stallion, mare or gelding.

**CLASS 31 NOVICE PONY** Open to ponies in their first season of showing (from January 2022). Ponies 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cm. Stallion, mare or gelding.

**CLASS 32 NOVICE RIDER** Open to riders in their first showing season (from January 2022). Ponies to be 4 years old and over and not exceeding 153cm. Stallion, mare or gelding

**CLASS 33 PART BRED PONY** Open to part-bred ponies 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cm. Stallion, mare or gelding.

**CLASS 34 OPEN PONY** Open to ponies of any type 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cm. Stallion, mare or gelding. Riders to be suitably mounted.

**CLASS 35 RIDDEN PONY CHAMPIONSHIP** For ponies that have been placed 1st & 2nd in Classes 22 - 34.  
**Champion - £30 Reserve Champion - £15 Second Reserve - £10**

- CLASS 48 PART BRED HORSE** Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Exceeding 153cm. Any age.

# RIDDEN HORSES

**To follow the Ridden Pony Classes in the Main International Indoor Arena (approx 1:30pm)**

- CLASS 51 INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE** Open Intermediate Riding Type stallion, mare or gelding. 4 years old and over, exceeding 146cm but not exceeding 158cm. Riders to not have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- CLASS 52 INTERMEDIATE SHOW HUNTER TYPE** Open Intermediate Hunter Type stallion, mare or gelding. 4 years old and over, exceeding 146cm but not exceeding 158cm. Riders to not have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- CLASS 53 RIDING HORSE** Open to Riding Horses aged 4 year old and over. Stallions, mares and geldings.
- CLASS 54 RETRAINED RACEHORSE** Open to horses that have previously raced or being in training and are 4 years old and over. Stallion, mare or gelding. Exceeding 153cm.
- CLASS 55 OPEN COB (EXCLUDING MAXI COBS)** Open to cobs (excluding maxi cobs) 4 years old and over. Stallion, mare or gelding. Exceeding 148cm.
- CLASS 56 OPEN MAXI COB** Open to maxi cobs aged 4 years old and over. Stallion, mare or gelding. Exceeding 148cm..
- CLASS 57 OPEN HACK** Open to Hacks 4 years old and over. Stallion, mare or gelding. To be exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 160cm.
- CLASS 58 HUNTER HORSE** Open ridden Hunter 4 years old and over. Stallion, mare or gelding. Exceeding 153cm.
- CLASS 59 OPEN COLOURED** Open to Piebald, Skewbald, Spotted, Appaloosa, Palomino horses 4 years old and over. Stallion, mare or gelding. Exceeding 153cm.
- CLASS 60 SPORTS HORSE** Open to Sports Horses 4 years old and over. Stallion, mare or gelding. Exceeding 153cm.
- CLASS 61 PURE/PART BRED ARAB** Open to both pure and part bred Arabs 4 years old and over. Stallion, mare or gelding. Exceeding 153cm.
- CLASS 62 PART BRED HORSE** Open to part-bred horses 4 years old and over, exceeding 153cm. Stallion, mare or gelding.
- CLASS 63 NOVICE HORSE** Open to horses in their first season of showing (from January 2022). Horses 4 years old and over and exceeding 153cm. Stallion, mare or gelding.
- CLASS 64 NOVICE RIDER** Open to riders in their first showing season (from January 2022). Horses to be 4 years old and over and exceeding 153cm. Stallion, mare or gelding.

**CLASS 65 RIDDEN HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP** For horses that have been placed 1st & 2nd in Classes 51 - 64.  
**Champion - £30 Reserve Champion - £15 Second Reserve - £10**

## Terms and Conditions & Show Rules

### GENERAL

1. These Terms and Conditions apply to all competitors and spectators and must be adhered to at all times. Entry into any competition, including the hire of the Centre, shall be deemed an acceptance of these Terms and Conditions
2. Aintree International Equestrian Centre, Aintree Racecourse Developments Limited and Aintree Racecourse Company Limited reserve the right to refuse entry/hire without stating the reason, to cancel the competition and all rights of admission.
3. Aintree International Equestrian Centre, Aintree Racecourse Developments Limited and Aintree Racecourse Company Limited do not accept any responsibility or liability for any injury, accident, damage or illness to any person, property or animal whatsoever, or for any loss whatsoever, arising out of, or occurring at any competition, show or event. It shall be a condition of entry, each entrant shall indemnify the organisers against any legal action whatsoever arising from any accident.
4. Everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the officials and stewards.

### ENTRIES AND PRIZE MONEY

1. All entry, stable and hire fees include VAT@ 20%. All entries and hire fees must be paid for in full prior to leaving the Show. A £15 administration fee will be payable on any outstanding accounts or dishonoured cheques, plus interest.
2. All prize money will be paid back onto the card you paid with to enter, unless you have won more than the amount initially paid in entries. In this case, a BACS form will need to be filled out at the Show Office before the payment can be processed. All prize money payment methods take between 2 and 10 working days.
3. All entries must be made on via Horse Monkey with full entry fees. Every Exhibitor and Competitor will be held responsible for the correctness of his or her entry forms and if he/she fails, when called upon by the Stewards or Show to prove the correctness of such entry, the entry may be disqualified and any award made to it cancelled.
4. Objection to entries or awards must be made in writing to the Secretary on the Show Day, accompanied by a deposit of £50 which will be refunded if the objection is sustained.

### VACCINATIONS

1. All horses and ponies attending must have a current and valid certificate of vaccination against equine flu within the last 12 months but not in the 7 day day prior to arriving. There will be random checking of certificates, any queries regarding this, please call the Show Secretary.

### SHOWGROUND RULES

1. No motor bikes or scooters are allowed on the Racecourse.
2. All dogs must be kept on leads and under proper control at all times and cleaned up after.
3. Any dogs that are prone to barking are not permitted in the indoor arena.
4. Any individual seen to be causing distress or suffering to any animal will be asked to leave the Racecourse and may be reported to the appropriate authorities.
5. Full and correct attire must be worn by all competitors when riding. For all classes all competitors and grooms, when mounted, must wear a British Standard skull/hard hat, which must be fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination. Aintree Equestrian Centre accepts no responsibility for any injury arising from a failure to comply with this.
6. Horses and ponies may be measured at the discretion of the Judge unless in possession of a valid J.M.B. height certificate.
7. No animal suffering from a contagious disease may be brought onto the Racecourse.
8. In the event of a Veterinary Surgeon advising the removal of any animal from the Show, his decision shall be final and immediately complied with.
9. All disputes shall be referred to the Aintree Equestrian Centre Organisers, whose decision is final.
10. Exhibitors are responsible for all costs in connection with any veterinary treatment given on the Showground and must be settled at the time with the Veterinary Surgeon concerned.
11. It is a condition of entry that exhibitors conform with the requirements of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and for ensuring that safe working practices are followed by themselves, their employees, Agents and Contractors. Exhibitors shall at all times comply with the instructions of the Show Officials.
12. Exhibitors Risk and Responsibility – Neither AINTREE RACECOURSE or AINTREE INTERNATIONAL EQUESTRIAN CENTRE, NOR ANY OF IT'S OFFICERS OR SERVANTS SHALL BE IN ANY WAY RESPONSIBLE or accountable for anything that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatsoever) to exhibitors or their servants or agents or to any exhibit or to any vehicle carrying any exhibit or anything else brought into the Showground or for anything else arising out of the Show. EACH EXHIBITOR shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss or injury or damage done to or commissioned by or arising from any animal or article exhibited by him or her and shall indemnify the Show against all legal or other proceedings in regard thereto.
13. Lunging is not permitted in any of the arenas.
14. Horses must be warmed up in the equipment that they are competing in. Draw reins are not permitted.

### CLASSES

1. No horse or pony under the age of 4 years shall be ridden in any class.
2. All lead rein riders not to have attained their 9th birthday.
3. All lead rein ponies not to exceed 128cm.
4. All first ridden riders not to have attained their 12th birthday.
5. All riders ages are calculated from the 1st January of the current year.
6. In all lead rein classes, the handlers lead rein must be attached to the noseband.
7. All novice competitors are asked to enter in the spirit intended.
8. Any rider that falls from their horse or pony in any class may not continue.
9. Any horse or pony that gets loose from its handler in any in hand class may not continue.
10. No horse or pony will be considered for a placing if it was not present for the initial go round from when the class goes into trot.
11. Snaffle bridles only in lead rein, first ridden and novice classes.
12. All competitors must be smartly and correctly dressed for all classes.
13. Spurs must not be worn by any junior riders under the age of 16 as of the 1st January in the current year. Spurs may be worn in any other classes at the judge's discretion.
14. Whips must not exceed 30", if a competitor excessively uses the whip in any classes they will be asked to leave the ring.
15. Back numbers should be worn in every class. Failure to do so will result in the competitor to be ineligible to compete.
16. No jewellery or visible body piercing are to be worn.
17. Stallions are not eligible for lead rein or first ridden classes.
18. Juniors who have not attained their 11th birthday as of the 1st January in the current year may not ride any m&m small breed pony stallion not exceeding 138cm.
19. Juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday as of the 1st January in the current year may not ride any m&m large breed pony stallion exceeding 138cm.
20. Stallions and colts (inc yearlings) may not be led by anyone who has not attained their 16th Birthday as of 1st January in the current year.
21. The Show cannot be responsible for the clashing of Classes and exhibitors should bear this in mind when making their entries. We cannot guarantee timings, it is up to the competitor to keep an eye on when their class is. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded if you miss your class or your class clashes.
22. Any competitor who is considered by the organisers, stewards, judges to have received outside assistance without prior permission, will be eliminated from the Class.
23. All Society registration numbers must be given where applicable.
24. All Competitor numbers are to be collected from the Secretary's Office on arrival at the Showground, if they have not been sent out in the post.
25. The Organisers reserve the right to appoint a replacement Judge whenever it is deemed necessary.
26. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, limit, divide or amalgamate any Class.
27. The decision of the Judge is final.

### REFUNDS

1. Refunds will not be given after the close of entries.
