Stabling FAQs





Q: How do I book stabling?

A: Stabling is booked through Aintree on HorseMonkey

Search 'RoR Stabling' on HorseMonkey or follow the link on our website.

Q: What time can I access my stable?

A: Stabling at Aintree runs **2pm to 2pm**.

Eg. If you have booked a Monday night stable. You can access your stable from 2pm Monday, and have it until 2pm Tuesday.




Q: What vaccinations does my horse need to stable at Aintree?

A: Your horse must have had a booster vaccination in the preceeding 6 months of the show, and be 6 days clear. So, the last vaccination must have been between **29th February 2023** and the **17th August 2023**.

Q: What do I do if I have started my horse's vaccinations again?

A: Your horse **must** have had the first two vaccinations of the primary course, and be 6 days clear in order to stable with us at Aintree.



Q: How do I know I have booked the right night/s?

A: Before your booking is processed, you will be asked which night/s your booking is for.

Q: Can I stable next to a friend?

A: If you wish to stable next to a friend, please add this as a note when you complete your booking and we will try to accomodate this.



Q: What bedding can I use in my stable?

A: Your stable booking includes **2 bales of bedding**. This will be either shavings or paper. You can purchase extra bedding from us, or bring your own. No straw please.

Q: Is there hay/haylage available?

A: We have hay and haylage available on site which can be purchased via HorseMonkey or when you arrive.
