## Do I need to qualify for this show?

You need to be qualified to jump in the Amateur classes at this show. Your age is your qualification for the Veteran classes (45 years and over).

#### Have I qualified?

Qualification for the National Amateur classes is through 5 double clears at first round shows or qualifying at a second round show.

British Showjumping will notify you with a certificate if you have qualified.

Please note that if you have qualified for the show through the amateur first and/or second rounds, you then need to qualify in the preliminary rounds (A & B classes) at the show to jump the finals on Sunday.

#### How does the block entry work?

You need to enter BOTH A and B Classes in your height section as it is a block entry, whether you jump both classes or not.

A - Preliminary Round (block entry)

B - Preliminary Round (block entry)

C - Final

## How do I qualify for the final?

The top 25 qualify for the amateur finals, which is passed down the line if competitors have already qualified in the A class. If there are more than 100 starters, one in four will qualify. Double clears in the A and B class also qualify for the final.

#### How do I enter the final?

If you qualify in the prelim classes (A or B) we will automatically enter you for the final (C). Please ensure you settle your account at the show office or withdraw from this class if you decide not to jump (before the draws are published on Saturday evening).

## Can I jump in the fun classes?

Absolutely and they really are fun! Anyone who is qualified to jump at the show, whether amateur or veteran can enter the fun classes. You must compete in a National Amateur or Veteran class to be eligible to compete in a fun class.

## When do entries and stables open?

Stables and entries open on Monday 7th October at 12noon

We advise competitors to register with Horse Monkey before we go live with entries.

Stables are located in the services section on Horse Monkey.

Stables will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

All stables are on concrete/tarmac or hard standing, apart from 20 premium permanent stables which have rubberised floors and walls.

Two bales of bedding (shavings or paper in permanents, shavings in temporary stables) are included in the price of the stable.

#### When do entries and stables close?

**ENTRIES close on Friday 1st November at midnight**. Some classes may close early if they reach capacity.

WARNING - Entries and stabling & other services will also close early if we reach capacity.

#### What is the hostel accommodation?

Limited onsite hostel accommodation will also go on sale at the same time as stables and entries, one room with four beds, per booking

The rooms are basic but are located by the stables & consist of 4 single beds with bedding, cupboards, heating and electric with access to communal toilets and showers.

Dogs are not permitted in the rooms. Cooking is also not permitted in the rooms.

We advise bringing your own duvet and pillows for a bit of home comfort!



## Can I purchase additional horse bedding?

Additional bedding needs to be pre booked through Horse Monkey.

Bedding must be purchased direct from Aintree.

Hay and Haylage needs to be pre booked on Horse Monkey.

Large haylage bales are 5ft bales (225kg)

Large hay bales are not available at this year's show, but we do have a good supply of small standard hay bales.

Competitors are permitted to bring their own hay and haylage.




