CLASS 6 - IN HAND MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS (EXC WELSH)

Open to In Hand Mountain and Moorland ponies who are registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor & Shetland. **Excluding Welsh.** Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. All breeds must be show in Natural State only

CLASS 7 - IN HAND MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS (EXC WELSH)

Open to In Hand Mountain and Moorland ponies who are registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of New Forest, Connemara, Dales, Fell & Highland. **Excluding Welsh.** Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. All breeds must be show in Natural State only

CLASS 8 - IN HAND WELSH

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age, not exceeding 153cm



CLASS 9 - IN HAND STANDARD SHETLAND

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age, not exceeding 153cm

CLASS 10 - IN HAND MINIATURE SHETLAND

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age, not exceeding 153cm

CLASS 11 - IN HAND MINATURE HORSE

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age, not exceeding 153cm

CLASS 12 - IN HAND NATIVE/TRADITIONAL/COB COLOURED

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age, not exceeding 153cm

CLASS 13 - IN HAND NON NATIVE COLOURED

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age, not exceeding 153cm

CLASS 14 - IN HAND PART BRED

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age, not exceeding 153cm

CLASS 15 - IN HAND FOREIGN BREEDS & ALTERNATIVE COLOUREDS

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age & of foreign breed or spotted, appaloosa or palomino, not exceeding 153cm

CLASS 16 - IN HAND RESCUE PONY

Any age, type, breed. Mares with foal at foot are not permitted. No exhibit under the age of one year may be exhibited on its own. Open to - Any equine that is adopted, fostered, under a guardianship scheme from any National Equine Welfare Council registered Charity (NEWC). - Any equine that has been adopted, fostered, under a guardianship scheme from any other equine charity (must be registered with the Charity Commission). - Any equine that has been 'independently' rescued by an individual. There must be supporting evidence (photographic, veterinary) that will be included in the 'Rescue History' for the equine, to demonstrate their rescue status

CLASS 17 - IN HAND YOUNG HANDLER

Handler must be aged 4 - 16 years on the day of the show. Mare or gelding not exceeding 153cm

CLASS 18 - DIAMOND VETERAN IN HAND (25 YEARS AND OVER)

Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height. Highest placed M&M to qualify for the corresponding Supreme Final - on judges discretion

CLASS 19 - VETERAN IN HAND (20-24 YEARS)

Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height. Highest placed M&M to qualify for the corresponding Supreme Final - on judges discretion

CLASS 20 - PRE-VETERAN IN HAND (15-19 YEARS)

Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height. Highest placed M&M to qualify for the corresponding Supreme Final - on judges discretion

CLASS 21 - VETERAN SOCIETY IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

For the first and second prize winners in Classes 18-20. Champion Sash and Championship rosettes. Champion & Reserve Champion qualify for the Saturday Supreme Championship. 1st and 2nd place will qualify for the Ridden Pony Championship if they are eligible

CLASS 22 - RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LEAD REIN & FIRST RIDDEN

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. Lead rein Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant & shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. First Ridden Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle. Rosettes will be awarded for each section

CLASS 23 - RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER/SHOW PONY LEAD REIN & FIRST RIDDEN

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 122cm. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year for lead rein and not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year for First Ridden. Lead Reins to be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. Rosettes to 6th will be awarded for the lead rein and first ridden sections.

CLASS 24 - NOVICE PONY

Open to ponies in their first season of showing in 2024. Stallion, gelding or mare, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cm

CLASS 25 - NOVICE RIDER

Open to riders in their first season of showing in 2024. Stallion, gelding or mare, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cm

CLASS 26 - RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONY

Show Hunter Pony stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders any age

CLASS 27 - RIDDEN SHOW PONY

Show Pony stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders any age

CLASS 28 - RIDDEN PART BRED

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 153cm. Riders any age

CLASS 29 - RIDDEN FOREIGN BREEDS & ALTERNATIVE COLOUREDS

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age and of foreign breed or spotted, appaloosa or palomino, not exceeding 153cm



CLASS 30 - JUNIOR RIDER

Riders to be 15 years & under at time of entry and to be suitably mounted. Open to ponies 4 years and over, not exceeding 153cm

CLASS 31 - RIDDEN PLAITED COLOURED PONY

Plaited stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders any age

CLASS 32 - RIDDEN NATIVE/TRADITIONAL/COB COLOURED PONY

Open to Native/Traditional/Cob coloured ponies. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 153cm

CLASS 33 - RIDDEN TRADITIONAL GYPSY COB

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. Part breds are also permitted

CLASS 34 - RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS (EXC WELSH)

Open to In Hand Mountain and Moorland ponies who are registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor & Shetland Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. All breeds must be show in Natural State only

CLASS 35 - RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS (EXC WELSH)

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. All breeds must be show in Natural State only

CLASS 36 - RIDDEN WELSH

Open to stallion, mares and gelding Welsh ponies, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. If numbers are large, this class maybe split into sections

CLASS 37 - RIDDEN RESCUE PONY

Any age, type, breed. Mares with foal at foot are not permitted. No exhibit under the age of one year may be exhibited on its own. Open to - Any equine that is adopted, fostered, under a guardianship scheme from any National Equine Welfare Council registered Charity (NEWC). - Any equine that has been adopted, fostered, under a guardianship scheme from any other equine charity (must be registered with the Charity Commission). - Any equine that has been 'independently' rescued by an individual. There must be supporting evidence (photographic, veterinary) that will be included in the 'Rescue History' for the equine, to demonstrate their rescue status

CLASS 38 - DIAMOND VETERAN RIDDEN (25 YEARS AND OVER)

Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height. Highest placed M&M to qualify for the corresponding Supreme Final - on judges discretion

CLASS 39 - VETERAN RIDDEN (20-24 YEARS)

Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height. Highest placed M&M to qualify for the corresponding Supreme Final - on judges discretion

CLASS 40 - PRE-VETERAN RIDDEN (15-19 YEARS)

Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height. Highest placed M&M to qualify for the corresponding Supreme Final - on judges discretion

CLASS 41 - VETERAN SOCIETY RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

For the first and second prize winners in Classes 38-40. Champion Sash and Championship rosettes. 1st and 2nd place will qualify for the Ridden Pony Championship if they are eligible

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age, exceeding 153cm

CLASS 53 - IN HAND RETRAINED RACEHORSE

Horse must be RoR eligible. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age, exceeding 153cm

CLASS 54 - IN HAND HUNTER

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age, exceeding 153cm

CLASS 55 - IN HAND PURE/PART BRED ARAB

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age, exceeding 153cm

CLASS 56 - IN HAND IRISH DRAUGHT

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age, exceeding 153cm

CLASS 57 - IN HAND PART BRED

Any age & heavy breed, for horses exceeding 153cms.

Open to - Any equine that is adopted, fostered, under a guardianship scheme from any National Equine Welfare Council registered Charity (NEWC). - Any equine that has been adopted, fostered, under a guardianship scheme from any other equine charity (must be registered with the Charity Commission). - Any equine that has been 'independently' rescued by an individual. There must be supporting evidence (photographic, veterinary) that will be included in the 'Rescue History' for the equine, to demonstrate their rescue status

CLASS 60 - IN HAND FOREIGN BREEDS & ALTERNATIVE COLOUREDS

Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age and of foreign breed or spotted, appaloosa or palomino, exceeding 153cm

CLASS 61 - IN HAND SENIOR HANDLER

Handler any age with any type/age/sex of horse exceeding 153cm. To be judged on the ability of the Handler & presentation/performance of the horse. Conformation will NOT be taken into account

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cm and 2024 is its first season showing. Riders any age

CLASS 63 - NOVICE RIDER

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cm. Riders any age and 2024 is their first season showing

CLASS 64 - RIDDEN INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE

Intermediate Show Riding Type, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 146cm but not exceeding 158cm. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year

CLASS 65 - RIDDEN INTERMEDIATE SHOW HUNTER TYPE

Intermediate Show Hunter Type, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 158cm. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January

CLASS 66 - RIDDEN RIDING HORSE

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cm. Riders any age

CLASS 67 - RIDDEN RETRAINED RACEHORSE

Must be eligible for RoR classes. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cm. Riders any age

CLASS 68 - RIDDEN COB

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cm. Riders any age

CLASS 69 - RIDDEN HACK

Show Hack stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 160cm. Riders any age

CLASS 70 - RIDDEN HUNTER

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cm. Riders any age

CLASS 71 - RIDDEN PLAITED COLOURED HORSE

Piebald/Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cm. Riders any age

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cm. Riders any age

- 1. These Terms and Conditions apply to all competitors and spectators and must be adhered to at all times. Entry into any competition, including the hire of the Centre, shall be deemed an acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
- 2. Please also refer to the Aintree Racecourse Terms and Conditions which can be found at http://aintree.thejockeyclub.co.uk/pr-policies/terms-conditions.
- 3. All persons entering onto the Racecourse, by virtue of admission, agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions and the General Rules of the Competition.
- 4. Aintree International Equestrian Centre and Aintree Racecourse reserve the right to refuse entry/hire without stating the reason, and to cancel the competition and all rights of admission.
- 5. Any person causing any damage, disruption or unwanted behaviour will be asked to leave the premises and will not be permitted to participate any further in the show.
- 6. Aintree International Equestrian Centre and Aintree Racecourse do not accept any responsibility or liability for any injury, accident, damage or illness to any person, property or animal whatsoever, or for any loss whatsoever, arising out of, or occurring at any competition, show or event. It shall be a condition of entry/hire of the Centre that each entrant shall indemnify the organisers against any legal action whatsoever arising from any accident.
- 7. All competitors and attendees must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the officials and stewards.
- 8. Parents or guardians are deemed responsible for their children and they must be supervised at all times.
- 9. Please also note that the Collecting Ring area is for the purpose of warming up. It is strictly not a viewing or standing area, nor is it to be used by anyone other than those entered in the current class.
- 10. BRITISH STANDARD APPROVED HARD HATS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED. Full and correct attire must be worn by all competitors when competing or hiring the Centre. For show jumping all competitors and grooms, when mounted, must wear a British Standard skull/hard hat, which must be fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination.
- 11. Any individual seen to be causing distress or suffering to any animal will be asked to leave the Racecourse and may be reported to the appropriate authorities.
- 12. No horse or pony under the age of 4 years shall be ridden at any competition.
- 13. Any persons responsible for a stallion must ensure that they are secure at all times including within the stables and the collecting ring, and correctly displaying the appropriate FEI approved ribbons and discs.
- 14. All horses and ponies competing or using the Centre must be fully vaccinated against equine flu, and must not have had any vaccination in the 6 days prior to attending.
- 15. Vaccination requirements for stabling may vary from time to time, as dictated by the British Horseracing Authority. Please see individual event page for details. Important updates will be published on our website and on our social media pages.
- 16. Horses and/or ponies must not be left unattended at any time when tied outside Horseboxes or trailers. Haynets are not permitted outside.
- 17. No horse and/or pony may be lunged in any area of the Racecourse. Strictly no lunging in the arena or collecting ring.
- 18. Competitors are requested, prior to leaving, to clean up any droppings, hay, straw or shavings from around their horsebox/trailer and to dispose of these at in the dpoo skips and bins provided.
- 19. Dogs must be kept on leads AT ALL TIMES and must be cleaned up after. Failure to do this will result in you being asked to leave the Racecourse. No dogs are allowed on the Racecourse track or in the stable yards AT ANY TIME.
- 20. It is recommended that all vehicles are fitted with a fire extinguisher.
- 21. Aintree International Equestrian Centre reserves the right to alter any schedule at any time without prior notice. Closing dates for all shows may be altered if the classes are full.
- 22. All entry and hire fees include VAT@20%. All entries and hire fees must be paid for in full prior to leaving the Centre. A £15 administration fee will be payable on any outstanding accounts or dishonoured cheques, plus interest.
- 23. No entry or stable fees will be refunded.
- 24. Prize money not collected on the day will be forfeited.
- 25. If stables are in use for this show, a £30 cash deposit must be paid to the Stable Manager on arrival and will be returned once the stable has been inspected and has been fully emptied of bedding and hay.
- 26. Smoking or vaping is strictly forbidden in the stable area and in all buildings. Cigarette butts must be disposed of safely and in the bins provided.
- 27. All vehicles should be parked sensibly and enough room must be left for emergency access.
- 28. Any competitor who is considered by the organisers, stewards, judges to have received outside assistance without prior permission, will be eliminated from their Class.
- 29. It is the owners/riders responsibility to ensure that horses/ponies are the correct height for their Class.
- 30. The decision of the Judge on the day in all classes will be final.
- 31. Photographs will be taken at Equestrian and Racecourse events by a professional, licenced photographer who has been approved by ARDL. Aintree reserve the right to use these photographs for advertising purposes to promote future events. No other photographers are permitted to photograph the event.
- 32. Aintree Racecourse Developments Ltd use Horse Monkey as their chosen event administration system. Entry form details will be added to this system to inform competitors that their entries have been received. If competitors do not wish for this information to be shared with our chosen entry system, then we will not be able to process and accept your entry.
- 33. Please also refer to our Privacy Policy.
- 34. Draw reins are not permitted at this show.
- 35. Horses and ponies must only be warmed up by those who are riding them in the competition.
- 36. The Show cannot be responsible for the clashing of Classes and exhibitors should bear this in mind when making their entries. We cannot guarantee timings, it is up to the competitor to keep an eye on when their class is. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded if you miss your class or your class clashes.
- 37. REFUNDS will only be given on the production of a valid veterinary or medical certificate. Class entry fee and first aid fee will only be refunded. Online booking fee NOT included. Stables and hook ups (if available at the show) will not be refunded unless they have been resold.
- 38. Horses and ponies must only be warmed up by those who are riding them in the competition.
- 39. Grooms must wear a hat at all times if they are entering the competition arena.
- 40. Only tack that is permitted in the competition is permitted in the warm up.
- 41. Spurs can only be worn by adults, juniors are not permitted to wear spurs.
- 42. Horse/Pony grooming and prep must be done in or around your horsebox, not in or by the arena. No chalk permitted, other than in your lorries.
