All classes are open to both SSA Members and Non-Members and are to be ridden side saddle (with the exception of Class 14). Classes 11, 12, 14, 15, 16, 26, 29, 31, 33 and 34 are affiliated to the SSA and will be run under SSA rules as defined in the current Members Handbook. Adult riders not wearing a safety hat do so at their own risk and **must sign a disclaimer** at the Aintree Show Office prior to competing. Junior riders (age 17 years and under) **must wear a hard hat** that complies with current British Safety Standard or above at all times. Hard hats to current British Safety Standard or above **must be worn in all jumping classes**.

The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance, but detailed inspection of rider or tack is not required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the Judge may ask groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest Junior Member of SSA carrying their current Championship Points Card.

Class 10: The Conspiracy Theory - Adult Side Saddle Concours d'Elegance Kindly sponsored by Mrs Rosamund Lane and Mrs Sophie Lane-Keery -In memory of dearest Super-Ted

Judge: Mrs Janet Senior (Yorkshire)

The winner will receive the 'Conspiracy Theory' sash. Rosettes to sixth place. Entry Fee: £16 Open to SSA Adult Members and Non-Members aged 18 years and over on January 1st of the current year. The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance, but detailed inspection of rider or tack is not required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the Judge may ask groups of three or four riders to give short displays. Three Special rosettes will be awarded to the highest place Adult Members of the SSA wearing a silk hat, bowler hat and safety hat carrying their current Championship Points Cards. N.B. Silk hats are permitted to be worn by adults in this class at any time of day will be awarded to the highest Junior Member of SSA carrying their current Championship Points Card.

This class is open to riders aged 66 years and over on the 1st January of the current year. Competitors are required to walk and trot only in the go-round followed by a two minute freestyle show which may include canter if wished. To be judged on horsemanship skill, gracious style and performance.

Class 14: Family Horse or Pony

Open to Adult and Junior Riders

The winner will receive the 'Newclose Properties Trophy'. Rosettes to sixth place. Entry Fee: £16 Entrants will consist of one Adult and one Junior rider, at least one of who will ride side saddle. The Adults will enter the arena on their horse/pony together for the initial judging which will include walk, trot and canter in the go-round, after which the Junior will give a two-minute maximum freestyle show. The Junior must be of suitable size and competence to control their horse/pony. Riders may ride more than one horse in this class. Competitors are not required to jump.

Class 15: Best Coloured Horse or Pony

The winner will receive the 'SSA Area 18 Trophy'. Rosettes to sixth place. Entry Fee: £16

This class is open to all coloured horses and ponies. Exhibits will not be stripped. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter in the go-round followed by a two-minute freestyle show.

Class 16: Historical Side Saddle Class

Resume and photograph must not exceed one A4 size sheet of paper and be clearly marked with the Competitor's name.

The Judge will request a short show. Traditional habits must be worn. N.B. Silk hats are permitted to be worn in this class at any time of the day. Judges are requested to use the mark sheet provided. Open to SSA Adult Members and Non-Members, aged 18 and over on January 1st of the current year, riding side saddle, on horses exceeding 148cm (14.2hh). To be judged 25% conformation and action, 25% manners & way of going, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider, Judges may request a short show but will not ride exhibits; horses will not be stripped. Traditional habits must be worn. Fancy Dress and Period Costumes not permitted. NB Silks Hats are permitted to be worn in this class at any time of the day. Judges must use the mark sheet provided. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. In the event of previous qualification, this may be passed down to fourth place. One special rosette and the qualification card will be given to the qualifying combination each show, this may not always be the winner. If the winner has already qualified they may be passed down to fourth place. Qualifiers kindly sponsored by Mrs. T. Mitchell and Mr. L. Mitchell. Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the SSA 21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show or as soon as possible if qualified after that date to be eligible to compete at the Final. Combinations qualifying between one National Side Saddle Show and the next may carry forward the qualification, for that year only.

The four highest placed Riding Horse, Hack (not ex 160cm), Cob or Hunter, Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over, ridden by a SSA Adult Member qualify for the current year's BSHA Championship Show Mears Ladies Show Horse Championship and if already qualified the ticket will go to the **highest placed horse down to 5th place**. Combinations qualifying after the current year's BSHA Championship Show may carry forward the qualification, to the following year. SSA Members who qualify for The Mears Ladies Show Horse Championship, will not be required to join the BSHA in order to compete in any Side Saddle class at the BSHA National Championship Show. If the BSHA Championship Show entries have closed at the time of qualification, competitors will not be charged a late entry fee for the Championship. Continued on next page...

PENALTIES - Third Refusal will result in disqualification. Fall of pony or rider in any phase will result in disqualification. If the total after Phase One is minus it must be carried forward to Phase Two. Half or Plus Marks are not permitted. IN THE EVENT OF A TIE OR TIES - The marks MUST NOT be altered. The TOTAL MARK from PHASE ONE will take precedence, followed by the Manners Mark, and then the Conformation Mark. If there is still a tie the Judge's decision is final. There may be no change of rider from Phase One to Phase Two. Hind Boots are not permitted in any class. Front Boots including Over-reach boots of a plain colour may be used for Phase One of the Classes ONLY. No bandages or protective pads or gel pads on pony/horse's legs or feet are permissible. No change of saddlery is allowed between Phases in a class. Whips are not considered tack. Body Protectors MUST be worn when jumping in any WH classes, including in the practice ring. Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all events. A British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) approved and appropriately labelled "Level 3 body protector" with the year 2009 (purple) or 2018 (Blue and Black) shown on the label manufactured in the year 2009. BETA recommends body protectors are replaced at least every three to five years, after which the impact absorption properties of the foam may have started to decline. All types of Air Jackets are not allowed.
