## IN HAND SHB(GB) HUNTER CLASSES

#### SATURDAY 31ST AUGUST - RING 1 - 8am START

Judge: Mrs S Stockley Bridges (Merseyside)

Entry Fee: £20

Hunter Breeding Classes are open to the produce of any Stallion and should not be confined to animals sired by Thoroughbreds. Foals up to three months old may be entered, but must subsequently be registered. Foals unnamed will be recorded under their dam. Two and three-year-old Brood Mares are not allowed to enter in Youngstock Classes. Manners will be taken into account in Hunter Breeding Classes. a) Broodmares to be eligible for Hunter Brood Mare Classes mares must have foal at foot or a relevant certificate of pregnancy for the following year which may be inspected at the show. Mares which have not yet foaled or that have lost their foals are eligible to enter with a relevant certificate of pregnancy that may be inspected at the show. b) Foals To be eligible to enter Hunter Foal Classes the foal must be at least four weeks old on the day of the show.

S.H.B.(G.B) in the North West – In-Hand Points Competition. Hunter Breeding Classes and In-hand Sport Horse Classes at the show are included in the S.H.B.(G.B) in the North West In-Hand Points Competition. Points will be awarded to 1st - 4th places in each class. Horses must be registered with SHB and the owner must be a current SHB member at the time of the show to qualify for entry into the Points Competition. An award will be made to the horse attaining the highest number of points overall.

#### Class 1 HUNTER BROOD MARE - HUNTER BROOD MARE PREMIUM AWARD:

Sport Horse of Great Britain offers one Premium in Class 1; the premium will take the form of a Service Voucher to be used for the service of the Mare by any SHB (GB) Graded or Life Approved Premium Stallion in 2025 or 2026. The premium will be awarded at the judge's discretion to his selection from the prize winners. The winning Mare must already be registered with the SHB (GB) and the owner must be or become a fully paid up member. Only one award per year may be accepted. The Premium will only be awarded if a minimum of three Mares are forward. The owner must be, or become a fully paid up member of SHB(GB) in order to be eligible for the award.

**Class 2 HUNTER FOAL** - In hand colt, gelding or filly, foaled in 2024, foals to be at least 4 weeks old on day of show.

Class 3 HUNTER YEARLING - In hand colt filly or gelding.

Class 4 HUNTER 2 YEAR OLD- In hand colt filly or gelding.

Class 5 HUNTER 3 YEAR OLD - In hand colt filly or gelding.

Class 6 HUNTER ANY AGE (Unaffiliated) - In hand colt, filly mare or gelding, any age.

**Class 7 IN HAND HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP** - For the 1st and 2nd prize winners from the above classes. Champion Sash and Championship rosettes. The Champion will qualify for THE PRICE FAMILY SUPREME IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP HOYS QUALIFIER, CLASS 400.



## IN HAND SPORTS HORSE SECTION

## SATURDAY 31ST AUGUST - RING 1 TO FOLLOW THE COLOURED CLASSES

Judge: Mr M Fitton (Manchester)

Entry Fee: £20

- a) These classes are for young athletic horses that have the conformation and movement to go to the top of their sphere.
- b) Each horse is judged individually on a triangle (except for foals) and walked round the ring as a class.
- c) Marks are awarded for conformation, walk, trot and type and temperament.
- d) A special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed horse in each class.
- e) The Leader who enters the ring with the horse must remain throughout the class.
- f) Any exhibitor in charge of an entire must ensure they are in complete control at all times and if not, will be dismissed from the ring.
- g) All entries in Sport Horse classes must be on the Society's Basic Identity Record or Stud Book.
- h) The Society discourages the showing of over-fat horses and judges will take this into consideration when making their awards.
- i) Manners will be taken into account in In Hand Sport Horse Classes.

#### All entries in SPORT HORSE (GB) Classes must be on the Society's Basic Identity Record or Stud Book

Current registration numbers must be quoted on Entry Forms

Sport Horse Breeding Classes are open to the produce of any Stallion and should not be confined to animals sired by Thoroughbreds. Foals up to three months old may be entered, but must subsequently be registered. Foals unnamed will be recorded under their dam. Two and three-year-old Brood Mares are not allowed to enter in Youngstock Classes. Manners will be taken into account in Sports Horse Breeding Classes. a) Broodmares to be eligible for Sports Horse Brood Mare Classes mares must have foal at foot or a relevant certificate of pregnancy for the following year which may be inspected at the show. Mares which have not yet foaled or that have lost their foals are eligible to enter with a relevant certificate of pregnancy that may be inspected at the show. b) Foals to be eligible to enter Sports Horse Foal Classes the foal must be at least four weeks old on the day of the show.

**SHB(GB) (IN THE NORTH WEST) - IN-HAND POINTS COMPETITION** Sport Horse Young Stock Classes are included in the SHB(GB) in the North West Points Competition. Points will be awarded to 1st - 4th places in each class. Horses must be registered with SHB and the owner must be a current SHB member at the time of the show to qualify for entry into the Points Competition. An award will be made to the horse attaining the highest number of points overall.

#### Class 8 SPORTS HORSE BROOD MARE - SPORTS HORSE BROOD MARE PREMIUM AWARD:

Sport Horse of Great Britain offers one Premium in this class; the premium will take the form of a Service Voucher to be used for the service of the Mare by any SHB (GB) Graded or Life Approved Premium Stallion in 2025 or 2026. The premium will be awarded at the judge's discretion to his selection from the prize winners. The winning Mare must already be registered with the SHB (GB) and the owner must be or become a fully paid up member. Only one award per year may be accepted. The Premium will only be awarded if a minimum of three Mares are forward. The North West Branch of the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain are pleased to offer a £50 Premium and Rosette to the 1st or 2nd placed Brood Mare, with own foal at foot, which has not already won a S.H.B.G.B. (In the North West) Premium during the 2024 season.

**Class 9 SPORTS HORSE FOAL** - Colt, gelding or filly foaled in 2024. Foals to be at least 3 weeks old on day of show.

Class 10 SPORTS HORSE YEARLING - Any colt, gelding or filly foaled in the preceding year.

Class 11 SPORTS HORSE 2 YEAR OLD - Any colt, gelding or filly foaled two yrs previously.

Class 12 SPORTS HORSE 3 YEAR OLD- Any colt, gelding or filly foaled three yrs previously.

**Class 13 SPORTS HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP** - For the 1st and 2nd prize winners from the above classes. Champion Sash and Championship rosettes. The Champion will qualify for THE PRICE FAMILY SUPREME IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP HOYS QUALIFIER, CLASS 400.

A Prize will be awarded for the highest placed Small Hunter Broodmare. White arm band to be worn. SHB of GB Registered number must be quoted on the Entry form.

**Class 15 LIGHT HORSE FOAL:** To exceed 14.2hh (148cm) at maturity. the foal must be at least 4 weeks old on the day of the show.

**Class 16 LIGHT HORSE YEARLING** Colt, Gelding or Filly foaled in 2023. To exceed 14.2hh (148cm) at maturity .SHB of GB Registered number must be quoted on the Entry Form.

**Class 17 LIGHT HORSE TWO YEAR OLD** Colt, Gelding or Filly foaled in 2022. To exceed 14.2hh (148cm) at maturity. SHB of GB Registered number must be quoted on the Entry Form.

**Class 18 LIGHT HORSE THREE YEAR OLD** Colt, Gelding or Filly foaled in 2021. To exceed 14.2hh (148cm) at maturity. SHB of GB Registered number must be quoted on the Entry form.

**Class 19 LIGHT HORSE IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP** – For the 1st and 2nd prize winners from the above classes. Champion Sash and Championship rosettes. The Champion will qualify for THE PRICE FAMILY SUPREME IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP HOYS OUALIFIER. CLASS 400.



## IRISH DRAUGHT IN HAND SECTION

## SATURDAY 31ST AUGUST - RING 1 TO FOLLOW THE LIGHT HORSE CLASSES

Entry Fee: £20

The following classes are affiliated to the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) and only horses registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership are eligible for entry. All Pure Bred Breeding and Youngstock In-hand exhibits must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (Class 1, Class 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register OR registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.

The owners of all Pure Bred Irish Draught horses must be full members of the IDHS (GB). This rule does not apply to owners of Irish Draught Sport Horses. Registration numbers to be stated on the entry form and entries will be sent to the IDHS (GB) prior to the Show to confirm eligibility.

All Yearling, Two and Three year old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over. All Three year old colts must be un-inspected.

Class 20 IRISH DRAUGHT OR IRISH DRAUGHT SPORT HORSE YOUNGSTOCK - 1, 2, 3 year old Colt, Filly or Gelding by an RID (GB), ID Class 1 or ID Class 2 sire out of a Graded\* dam OR 1, 2, 3 year old Colt, Filly or Gelding registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Registers. (NB: 3 yr old colts must be un-inspected.)

**Class 21 IRISH DRAUGHT PURE BRED MATURITY** - 4 yrs old and over, registered or overstamped by the IDHS (GB).

**Class 22 IRISH DRAUGHT SPORT HORSE MATURITY** - 4 yrs old and over, Mare or Gelding, registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Registers, or SID.

**Class 23 IRISH DRAUGHT OR IRISH DRAUGHT SPORTS HORSE BROODMARE** - Graded\* Mare, 3 yrs old and over, with own foal at foot, or 4 yrs old and over, in foal, OR Mare, 4 yrs old and over, with own foal at foot or in foal, registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Registers, or SID. Rosettes to the highest placed Pure Bred Mare and the highest placed Part Bred Mare.

**Class 24 IRISH DRAUGHT OR IRISH DRAUGHT SPORT HORSE FOAL** - eligible for Class 1 on the Irish Draught Breed Register, OR eligible for the Irish Draught Sport Horse Registers.

**Class 25 IRISH DRAUGHT BREEDING IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP** – For the 1st and 2nd prize winners from Classes 20, 23 & 24. Champion Sash and Championship rosettes. The Champion will qualify for THE PRICE FAMILY SUPREME IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP HOYS QUALIFIER, CLASS 400.

\*Please note that if the Champion is not a Broodmare, Stallion or 3 years old & under, the qualification for Price Family Championship will be passed to the reserve champion who will also need to be a Broodmare, Stallion or under 3 years of age.

**Class 26 IRISH DRAUGHT MATURITY IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP** – For the 1st and 2nd prize winners from Classes 21 & 22. Champion Sash and Championship rosettes.

The first placed horse in each class will qualify for the final at NPS Summer Championship show. Qualification may go no lower than third place. Foals are excluded from qualifying. Qualifier for NPS Hack Champions Prelim Rounds Qualifier for the Great British In Hand Show - Bury Farm 7TH SEPTEMBER 2024.

**Class 27 SMALL & LARGE HACK YEARLING** - Colts, fillies and gelding yearling. Need to be a Member of BSHA or have a Day Ticket. Small - to make between 148cms- 154cms at maturity. Not to exceed 148cm on day. Large- to make between 154cms-160cm at maturity. Not to exceed 154cms on day

**Class 28 SMALL & LARGE HACK YOUNGSTOCK** - Colts, fillies and geldings 2 & 3 yrs old. Need to be a Member of BSHA or have a Day Ticket. Small - to make between 148cms- 154cms at maturity. Not to exceed 153cm on day. Large- to make between 154cms-160cm at maturity. Not to exceed 159cms on day.

**Class 29 SMALL & LARGE HACK 4 YRS AND OVER** – Mares, stallions, geldings. Need to be a Member of BSHA or have a Day Ticket. Exceeding 148cms, not exceeding 160cms.

**Class 30 HACK BROODMARE** certified in foal, pregnancy certificates must be produced on the day or with own foal at foot, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms, but not exceeding 160cms.

Class 31 HACK BREEDING CHAMPIONSHIP - For the 1st and 2nd prize winners from the above classes. Champion Sash and Championship rosettes. The Champion will qualify for THE PRICE FAMILY SUPREME IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP HOYS QUALIFIER, CLASS 400.

\*Please note that if the Champion is not a Broodmare, Stallion or 3 years old & under, the qualification for Price Family Championship will be passed to the reserve champion who will also need to be a Broodmare, Stallion or under 3 years of age.

**Class 32 RIDING HORSE SMALL AND LARGE YEARLING** Colts, fillies and geldings, yearling. Need to be a Member of BSHA or have a Day Ticket. Small- to make between 148cms - 158cms at maturity. Not to exceed 150cms on day. Large - to make more than 158cms. To exceed 150cms on day.

**Class 33 RIDING HORSE SMALL AND LARGE YOUNGSTOCK**- Colts, fillies and geldings, 2 & 3 yrs old. Need to be a Member of BSHA or have a Day Ticket. Small- to make between 148cms - 158cms at maturity. Not to exceed 157cms on day. Large - to make more than 158cms. To exceed 157cms on day.

**Class 34 RIDING HORSE SMALL AND LARGE 4 YRS AND OVER** – Mares, stallions, geldings. Need to be a Member of BSHA or have a Day Ticket. Exceeding 148 cms

**Class 35 RIDING HORSE BROODMARE** 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms. Certified in foal, pregnancy certificates must be produced on the day or with own foal at foot.

Class 36 RIDING HORSE BREEDING CHAMPIONSHIP - For the 1st and 2nd prize winners from the above four classes. Champion Sash and Championship rosettes. The Champion will qualify for THE PRICE FAMILY SUPREME IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP HOYS QUALIFIER, CLASS 400.

If the Champion has already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2024 or is ineligible, then the Reserve Champion of that section may come forward, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible.

If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2024 or are ineligible then the section will not be represented in this qualifying round.

Foal champions are not eligible.

In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the qualification will not pass down to the Reserve Champion in the 2nd and any subsequent sections.

There will be no direct entry into Supreme In-hand Championship Qualifier, all animals must be a section champion or reserve champion (as applicable).

This is a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier, all data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. For full policy details please visit www.grandstandentries.com.




## Aintree International Equestrian Centre (Trading as Aintree Racecourse Developments Limited) Terms and Conditions

- 1. These Terms and Conditions apply to all competitors and spectators and must be adhered to at all times. Entry into any competition, including the hire of the Centre, shall be deemed an acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

- 3. All persons entering onto the Racecourse, by virtue of admission, agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions and the General Rules of the Competition.
- 4. Aintree International Equestrian Centre and Aintree Racecourse reserve the right to refuse entry/hire without stating the reason, and to cancel the competition and all rights of admission.
- 5. Any person causing any damage, disruption or unwanted behaviour will be asked to leave the premises and will not be permitted to participate any further in the show.
- 6. Aintree International Equestrian Centre and Aintree Racecourse do not accept any responsibility or liability for any injury, accident, damage or illness to any person, property or animal whatsoever, or for any loss whatsoever, arising out of, or occurring at any competition, show or event. It shall be a condition of entry/hire of the Centre that each entrant shall indemnify the organisers against any legal action whatsoever arising from any accident
- 7. All competitors and attendees must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the officials and stewards.
- 8. Parents or guardians are deemed responsible for their children and they must be supervised at all times.
- 9. Please also note that the Collecting Ring area is for the purpose of warming up. It is strictly not a viewing or standing area, nor is it to be used by anyone other than those entered in the current class.
- 10. BRITISH STANDARD APPROVED HARD HATS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED. Full and correct attire must be worn by all competitors when competing or hiring the Centre. For show jumping all competitors and grooms, when mounted, must wear a British Standard skull/hard hat, which must be fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination.
- 11. Any individual seen to be causing distress or suffering to any animal will be asked to leave the Racecourse and may be reported to the appropriate authorities.
- 12. No horse or pony under the age of 4 years shall be ridden at any competition.
- 13. Any persons responsible for a stallion must ensure that they are secure at all times including within the stables and the collecting ring, and correctly displaying the appropriate FEI approved ribbons and discs.
- 14. All horses and ponies competing or using the Centre must be fully vaccinated against equine flu, and must not have had any vaccination in the 6 days prior to attending.
- 15. Vaccination requirements for stabling may vary from time to time, as dictated by the British Horseracing Authority. Please see individual event page for details. Important updates will be published on our website and on our social media pages.
- 16. Horses and/or ponies must not be left unattended at any time when tied outside Horseboxes or trailers.
- 17. No horse and/or pony may be lunged in any area of the Racecourse. Strictly no lunging in the arena or collecting ring.
- 18. Competitors are requested, prior to leaving, to clean up any droppings, hay, straw or shavings from around their horsebox/trailer and to dispose of these at home.
- 19. Dogs must be kept on leads AT ALL TIMES and must be cleaned up after. Failure to do this will result in you being asked to leave the Racecourse. No dogs are allowed on the Racecourse track or in the stable yards AT ANY TIME.
- 20. It is recommended that all vehicles are fitted with a fire extinguisher.
- 21. Aintree International Equestrian Centre reserves the right to alter any schedule at any time without prior notice. Closing dates for all shows may be altered if the classes are full.
- 22. All entry and hire fees include VAT@20%. All entries and hire fees must be paid for in full prior to leaving the Centre. A £15 administration fee will be payable on any outstanding accounts or dishonoured cheques, plus interest.
- 23. No entry or stable fees will be refunded, unless the show is cancelled due to Covid 19 reasons.
- 24. Prize money not collected on the day will be forfeited.
- 25. If stables are in use for a show, a £20 cash deposit must be paid to the Stable Manager on arrival and will be returned once the stable has been inspected and has been fully emptied of bedding and hay.
- 26. Smoking is strictly forbidden in the stable area and in all buildings. Cigarette butts must be disposed of safely and in the bins provided.
- 27. All vehicles should be parked sensibly and enough room must be left for emergency access.
- 28. Any competitor who is considered by the organisers, stewards, judges to have received outside assistance without prior permission, will be eliminated from their Class.
- 29. It is the owners/riders responsibility to ensure that horses/ponies are the correct height for their class.
- 30. The decision of the Judge on the day in all classes will be final.
