Entries are now open and are **online only** via HorseMonkey.

Entries will close at 12pm on **Monday 9th June 2025**.

Late entries may be accepted until Monday 16th June 2025, with a £10 surcharge. All competitors must pay a **£5 First Aid Fee each day entered**.

All classes are open to both SSA Members and Non-Members and are to be ridden side saddle (with the exception of Classes 5,12,19&32). Classes 8,9,15,16,26,28,29,30&31 are affiliated to the SSA and will be run under SSA rules as defined in the current Members' Handbook. Adult riders not wearing a safety hat do so at their own risk and **must sign a disclaimer** at the Aintree Show Office prior to competing. Junior riders (age 18 years and under) **must wear a hard hat** that complies with current British Safety Standard or above at all times. Hard hats to current British Safety Standard or above **must be worn in all jumping classes**.

Class 3: Dressage Freestyle to Music

Intro - Prelim - Novice - Elementary

Section 3A Open to Lead Rein and Non-Lead Rein Junior riders, 12 Years and Under

Section 3B Open to Riders 13 Years and Over

Kindly sponsored by Wonkey Donkey Rosettes & Sashes

Judges: Mrs Yvonne Huber (Sussex) (C Line) and Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire) (E/B Line)

The winner of each section will receive the 'Wonky Donky Trophy'. Rosettes to sixth place and prizes in kind to all competitors

Entry Fee: £16.50

To be ridden under BD rules, with the exception of biting. SSA biting rules apply.

Test selection must be stated at time of entry.

Class 4: 'Strictly Prancing' Themed Costume - Walk, Trot & Canter

Section 4A Open to Riders 12 Years and Under

Section 4B Open to Riders 13 Years and Over

Judges: Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire) (C Line) and Mrs Yvonne Huber (Sussex) (E/B Line)

The winner of each section will receive the 'SD and MGS SC Trophy'. **Rosettes to sixth place and mementos to all competitors. Special award to the competitor, who in the opinion of the sponsor presents the 'Best Costume Wow Factor'.**

Entry Fee: £16.50

A freestyle to music competition. Costume themed to match and enhance your chosen music. To be judged on how much the performance captivates the judges and entertains the crowds. Arena size is 20m x 60m. Props optional. **Performance not to exceed 4.5 minutes.** Timed from start salute to final salute. A clearly labelled music tape must be submitted **to the RSSSG Stand at least 1 hour before start of competition.**

On foot competitions, no horse required!

Class 5. Costume Class with a Side Saddle Influence

Open to Adult and Juniors - On foot competition - no horse required!

Judge: Mrs Anne Chambers (Yorkshire)

The winner will receive the 'Wilkins Costume Trophy' Rosettes and prizes in kind to all competitors.

Entry Fee: £11.50

Judging will take place in the hospitality area at the ring side. Competitors will be asked to show their costumes in a cat-walk style parade before lining up for closer inspection. To be judged on creativity and imagination incorporating a side saddle influence! Competitors are required to submit a resumé of their costume with their entry form, which will be referred to by the Judge and Commentator. Resumé must not exceed one A 4 size sheet of paper and be clearly marked with the Competitor's name.

Class 6: Best Turned Out – *Kindly sponsored by G Hughs and Son*

Section 6A Open to Lead Rein and Non-Lead Rein Junior Riders, 12 years and under

Section 6B Open to Adult and Junior Riders, 13 Years and Over

Judge: Mrs Anne Chambers (Yorkshire)

The winner will receive the 'G Hughs and Son Trophy'. **Rosettes to sixth place and mementos to all competitors. Entry Fee: £11.50**

Times will be allocated for competitors to present themselves before the judge.

Class 7: Foundation Walk and Trot Freestyle Equitation

Kindly sponsored by Alison Henderson-Owen

Open to Junior Riders aged 12 years and under

Judge: Mrs Yvonne Huber (Sussex)

The winner will receive the 'Benison Trophy'. **Rosettes to sixth place and prizes in kind to all competitors. Entry Fee: £16.50**

This class is open to Lead Rein and Non-Lead Rein Junior riders who have not attained their 13th birthday on 1st January of the current year's show. Competitors will walk only in the go-round. Each competitor will be asked to give a freestyle show **not exceeding 2 minutes**. Cantering is **not permitted** for this class.

Class 8: Junior Side Saddle Concours d'Elegance

Kindly sponsored by the Bevan Family

Open to Junior Riders aged 17 years and under

Judge: Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the 'Bevan Family' sash. **Rosettes to sixth place. Entry Fee: £16.50**

This class is open to Juniors who have not attained their 18th birthday on 1st January of the current year's show. The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance, but detailed inspection of rider or tack is not required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the Judge may ask groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest Junior Member of SSA carrying their current Championship Points Card.

Class 9: *The Conspiracy Theory* – Adult Side Saddle Concours d'Elegance

Kindly sponsored by Mrs Rosamund Lane and Mrs Sophie Lane-Keery –

In memory of dearest Super-Ted

Judge: Mrs Yvonne Huber (Sussex)

The winner will receive the 'Conspiracy Theory' sash. **Rosettes to sixth place.**

Entry Fee: £16.50

Open to SSA Adult Members and Non-Members aged 18 years and over on January 1st of the current year. The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance, but detailed inspection of rider or tack is not required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the Judge may ask groups of three or four riders to give short displays. A Special rosettes will be awarded to the highest place Adult Member of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards. N.B. Silk hats are permitted to be worn by adults in this class at any time of day.

Class 10: The 'Senior' Side Saddle Gracious Ladies 'Horsemanship' Class

Kindly sponsored by The Senior Family

Section 10a Open to Adult Riders aged 40 – 59 years.

Section 10b Open to Adult Riders aged 60 years and over.

Judge: Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the '**Senior Family Trophy**'. **Rosettes to sixth place and mementos to all competitors.** The '**Senior International Side Saddle Award**' will be presented to all Gracious Ladies aged 70 years and over. **Entry Fee:** £16.50

Competitors are required to walk and trot only in the go-round followed by a two minute freestyle show which may include canter if wished. To be judged on horsemanship skill, gracious style and performance.

Class 11: Mixed Native Breeds Class

Kindly sponsored by Miss K Ettritch

Section 11a Open to Lead Rein and Non-Lead Rein Junior Riders, 10 years and under.

Competitors are required to walk and trot in the go-round followed by a two-minute freestyle show. No cantering allowed.

Section 11b Open to Adults and Junior Riders, 11 years and over.

Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter in the go-round followed by a two-minute freestyle show.

Judge: Mrs Yvonne Huber (Sussex)

The winner will receive the '**Ettritch Trophy**'. **Rosettes to sixth place. Entry Fee:** £16.50

This class is open to Mountain and Moorland type horses/ponies, pure and part bred. Exhibits will not be stripped.

Class 12: Family Horse or Pony

Kindly sponsored by Newclose Properties

Open to Adult and Junior Riders

Judge: Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the '**Newclose Properties Trophy**'. **Rosettes to sixth place. Entry Fee:** £16.50

Entrants will consist of **one Adult and one Junior rider, at least one of whom will ride side saddle.**

The Adults will enter the arena on their horse/pony together for the initial judging which will include walk, trot and canter in the go-round, after which the Junior will give a **two-minute maximum freestyle show**. The Junior must be of suitable size and competence to control their horse/pony. Riders may ride more than one horse in this class. Competitors are not required to jump.

Class 13: Best Coloured Horse or Pony

Kindly sponsored by Mr R. Oultram and Mrs S. Oultram

Open to Adult and Junior Riders

Judge: Mrs Yvonne Huber (Sussex)

The winner will receive the '**Oultram Trophy**'. **Rosettes to sixth place. Entry Fee:** £16.50

This class is open to all coloured horses and ponies (Appaloosa, Dun, Palomino, Piebald or Skewbald, Roan, Cremello and such like coloured). Exhibits will not be stripped. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter in the go-round followed by a two-minute freestyle show.

Class 14: Historical Side Saddle Class

Kindly sponsored by Mrs S Fernside

Open to Adult and Junior riders (including Lead Rein)

Judges: Mrs Yvonne Huber (Sussex) and Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the '**Othello Trophy**' and **mementos to all competitors. Entry Fee:** £11.50

This class will be judged on horseback at walk. The Judge may then inspect competitors' attire and horse/pony's tack closely, for historical accuracy. Competitors are required to submit a resume and photograph of their costume with their entry form, to confirm authenticity, which will be referred to by the Judge and Commentator. Resume and photograph must not exceed one A4 size sheet of paper and be clearly marked with the Competitor's name.

Class 15: *The Side Saddle Association* Contemporary Ladies Side Saddle Qualifier

Kindly sponsored by Mrs T Mitchell and Mr L Mitchell

Judge: Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the '**Mitchell Trophy**'. **Rosettes to sixth place and prizes in kind to all competitors.**

Entry Fee: £16.50

Open to SSA Adult and Junior Members and Non-members riding a Native, Part Bred, Heavy or World Breed horse pony side saddle. **To be judged 25% suitability of horse/pony for rider, 25% manners and way of going for type, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider.** Conformation will not be taken into consideration. The Judge will request a short show. Traditional habits must be worn. N.B. Silk hats are permitted to be worn in this class **at any time of the day.**

Judges are requested to use the mark sheet provided. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. One special rosette and the qualification card will be given to the qualifying combination at each show, this may not always be the winner; if the winner has already qualified, they may be passed down to fourth place.

Qualifiers kindly sponsored by Southernden Side Saddles. Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the SSA **21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show** or as soon as possible if qualified after that date to be eligible to compete at the Final. Combinations qualifying between one National Side Saddle Show and the next may carry forward the qualification, for that year only.

Class 16: The Tessa Mitchell Classical Ladies Side Saddle Qualifier

Kindly sponsored by Mrs T Mitchell and Mr L Mitchell

Judge: Mrs Yvonne Huber (Sussex)

The winner will receive the '**Mitchell Trophy and Sash**'. **Rosettes to sixth place and prizes in kind to all competitors.**

Entry Fee: £16.50

Open to SSA Adult Members and Non-Members, aged 18 and over on January 1st of the current year, riding side saddle, on horses exceeding 148cm (14.2hh). **To be judged 25% conformation and action, 25% manners & way of going, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider.** Judges may request a short show but will not ride exhibits; horses will not be stripped.

Traditional habits must be worn. Fancy Dress and Period Costumes **not permitted**. NB Silks Hats are permitted to be worn in this class **at any time of the day.** Judges must use the mark sheet provided. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. In the event of previous qualification, this may be passed down to fourth place. One special rosette and the qualification card will be given to the qualifying combination each show, this may not always be the winner. If the winner has already qualified they may be passed down to fourth place.

Qualifiers kindly sponsored by Mrs. T. Mitchell and Mr. L. Mitchell. Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the SSA **21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show** or as soon as possible if qualified after that date to be eligible to compete at the Final. Combinations qualifying between one National Side Saddle Show and the next may carry forward the qualification, for that year only.

The four highest placed **Riding Horse, Hack** (not ex 160cm), **Cob or Hunter**, Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over, ridden by a SSA Adult Member qualify for the current year's **BSHA Championship Show Mears Ladies Show Horse Championship** and if already qualified the ticket will go to the highest placed horse down to 5th place. Combinations qualifying after the current year's BSHA Championship Show may carry forward the qualification, to the following year. **SSA Members** who qualify for **The Mears Ladies Show Horse Championship**, **will not be required to join the BSHA** in order to compete in any **Side Saddle class** at the BSHA National Championship Show. If the BSHA Championship Show entries have closed at the time of qualification, competitors will not be charged a late entry fee for the Championship.

NB: Competitors may only enter either the Contemporary (Class 15) or Classical (Class 16)) class and only qualify for one of the finals unless you have two horse/ponies of a different type.

Class 17: Masters 'Prix d'Excellence'

Section A: Masters 'Prix d'Excellence' Equitation Class

Kindly sponsored by Mr S Marchbank and Mrs C Marchbank

Open to Adult and Junior riders. **This is the first element of a two-part competition.**

Judges: Mrs Yvonne Huber (Sussex) (C Line) and Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire) (E/B Line)

The winner will receive the 'Marchbank Trophy'. **Rosettes to sixth place and mementos to all competitors.**

Entry Fee: £17.50

Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter in the go-round followed by a **two-minute maximum freestyle show**. To be judged on effective horsemanship, suppleness, straightness, and position of the rider. Manners of the horse and way of going.

Section B: Masters 'Prix d'Excellence' Jumping

Kindly sponsored by Mr S Marchbank and Mrs C Marchbank

This is the second element of a two-part competition.

Choose your own height of course: 60cms (2'0") 70cms (2'3") 76cms (2'6"). Heights must be declared at time of entry, on the entry form. To be judged on effective horsemanship, suppleness, straightness, position throughout all elements of each jump, i.e., the approach, take off, flight, landing and get away.

The results from Class 17a and 17b will be collated together and the **top six riders** will go forward to the **Masters 'Prix d' Excellence' Ride off**.

Class 18: Aintree Jumping Challenge

Kindly sponsored by AAA Road Rescue (Leyland)

Open to Adult and Junior Riders

Judge: Mrs Frann Penn (Warwickshire) (C Line) and Mrs Yvonne Huber (Sussex) (E/B Line)

The winner will receive the 'AAA Road Rescue Trophy'. **Rosettes to sixth place.**

Entry Fee: £17.50

Choose your height of course: 60cms (2'0"), 70cms (2'3"), 76cms (2'6"), 84cms (2'9"), 1m (3'3"). Heights must be declared on the entry form at time of entry. The course will consist of **eight** fences. Fences 4-8 will be timed against the clock and the fastest clear will determine the winner. In the event of no clear rounds the lowest fault in the fastest time will win.

The winner will receive the '**Wilkins International Costume Trophy**'. **Rosettes and prizes in kind to all competitors. Entry Fee: £11.50**

No costume or replica habits. Judging will take place in the hospitality area at the ring side. Competitors will be asked to show their habits in a cat-walk style parade. To be judged on historical correctness and overall appearance. Competitors are required to submit a resumé of their costume with their entry form, which will be referred to by the Judge and Commentator. Resumé must not exceed one A 4 size sheet of paper and be clearly marked with the Competitor's name.

Class 20: Foundation Working Hunter Horse or Pony

Kindly sponsored by SSA Area 2

Open to Adult and Junior Riders

Judge: Mrs Fan Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the 'SSA Area 2 Trophy'. Rosettes to sixth place.

Entry Fee: £18.50

The course will consist of nine fences: Minimum height 45cm/Maximum height 55cm/Spread 45cm.

Class 21: Mixed Height Working Hunter Horse or Pony

Kindly sponsored by SSA Area 19

Open to Adult and Junior Riders

Judge: Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the 'SSA Area 19 Trophy'. Rosettes to sixth place.

Entry Fee: £18.50

Choose your preferred height:

A. Minimum height 55cm/Maximum height 65cm/spread 55cm.

B. Minimum height 65cm/Maximum height 75cm/spread 65cm.

C. Minimum height 75cm/Maximum height 85cm/spread 75cm.

The course will consist of **nine fences**.

PENALTIES – Third Refusal will result in disqualification. Fall of pony or rider in any phase will result in disqualification. If the total after Phase One is minus it must be carried forward to Phase Two. Half or Plus Marks are not permitted. **IN THE EVENT OF A TIE OR TIES** – The marks MUST NOT be altered. The TOTAL MARK from PHASE ONE will take precedence, followed by the Manners Mark, and then the Conformation Mark. If there is still a tie the Judge's decision is final. There may be no change of rider from Phase One to Phase Two. Hind Boots are not permitted in any class. Front Boots including Over-reach boots of a plain colour may be used for Phase One of the Classes ONLY. No bandages or protective pads or gel pads on pony/horse's legs or feet are permissible. No change of saddlery is allowed between Phases in a class. Whips are not considered tack. Body Protectors MUST be worn when jumping in any WH classes, including in the practice ring. Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all events. A British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) approved and appropriately labelled "Level 3 body protector" with the year 2009 (purple) or 2018 (Blue and Black) shown on the label manufactured in the year 2009. BETA recommends body protectors are replaced at least every three to five years, after which the impact absorption properties of the foam may have started to decline. All types of Air Jackets are not allowed.

Class 22: 'Fancy' Dress Competition

Open to Lead Rein and Non-Lead Rein Junior riders aged 16 years and under & Adult Riders

Judge: Mrs Anne Chambers (Yorkshire)

The winner will receive the 'SSA Area 18 Trophy'. Rosettes and mementos to all competitors.

Entry Fee: £11.50

Class 23: Aintree Ex-Racehorse 'Picture of Elegance' Side Saddle Horse

Kindly sponsored by Miss L Hanna

Open to all Ex-Racehorses

Judge: Miss Yvonne Huber (Sussex)

The winner will receive the 'Harp Player Trophy'. Rosettes to sixth place.

Entry Fee: £16.50

To be judged on the picture of elegance and graceful way of going. Riders will be required to walk, trot and canter in the go-round followed by a **two-minute maximum freestyle show**.

Class 24. The Newcomers Walk and Trot Freestyle Equitation

Kindly sponsored by Acrecliffe Equestrian Centre

Open to Lead Rein and Non-Lead Rein Junior Riders, 10 years and under

Judge: Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the 'Acrecliffe Equestrian Centre Trophy' Rosettes to sixth place.

Entry Fee: £16.50

Competitors will walk in the go-round. Each competitor will be asked to give a freestyle show not exceeding 2 minutes. Canter is not permitted for this class.

Class 25. Veteran Horse or Pony

Kindly sponsored by The Side Saddle Sisters 'Elsie and Lola'

Open to horses and ponies aged 15 years and over.

Judge: Mrs Yvonne Huber (Sussex)

The winner will receive the 'Side Saddle Sisters Trophy' Rosettes to sixth place.

Entry Fee £16.50

The age of horse/pony must be displayed on the bridle. No galloping allowed. No cantering is permitted except in individual performances.

Class 26: Side Saddle Riding Club Horse/Pony

Kindly sponsored by Mr R. Jenkins - Malvern Saddle Company (Worcester)

Open to Adult and Junior riders

Judge: Mrs Yvonne Huber (Sussex)

The winner will receive the 'Malvern Saddle Company Trophy'. Rosettes to sixth place.

Entry Fee: £16.50

Open to horses and ponies 4 years old or over. Riders will be required to walk, trot and canter in the go-round followed by a short show including two small jumps, maximum 61cms (2'). The height may be adjusted during the class at the Judge's discretion. The class shall be judged on the show, the manners of horse/pony and its suitability for the rider. Conformation will not be considered.

Class 27: Fantasy Costume Class

Kindly sponsored by SSA Area 18

Open to Lead Rein and Non-Lead Rein Junior Riders & Adult Riders

Judge: Mrs Anne Chambers (Yorkshire)

The winner will receive the 'SSA Area 18 Trophy' and prizes in kind to all competitors.

Entry Fee: £11.50

Judged for creativity and inventiveness. Competitors are required to walk and trot only in the go-round and perform a two-minute freestyle show which may include canter if wished (with exception for lead rein competitors). Competitors are to submit a resumé of their costume with their entry form, which will be referred to by the Judge and Commentator.
