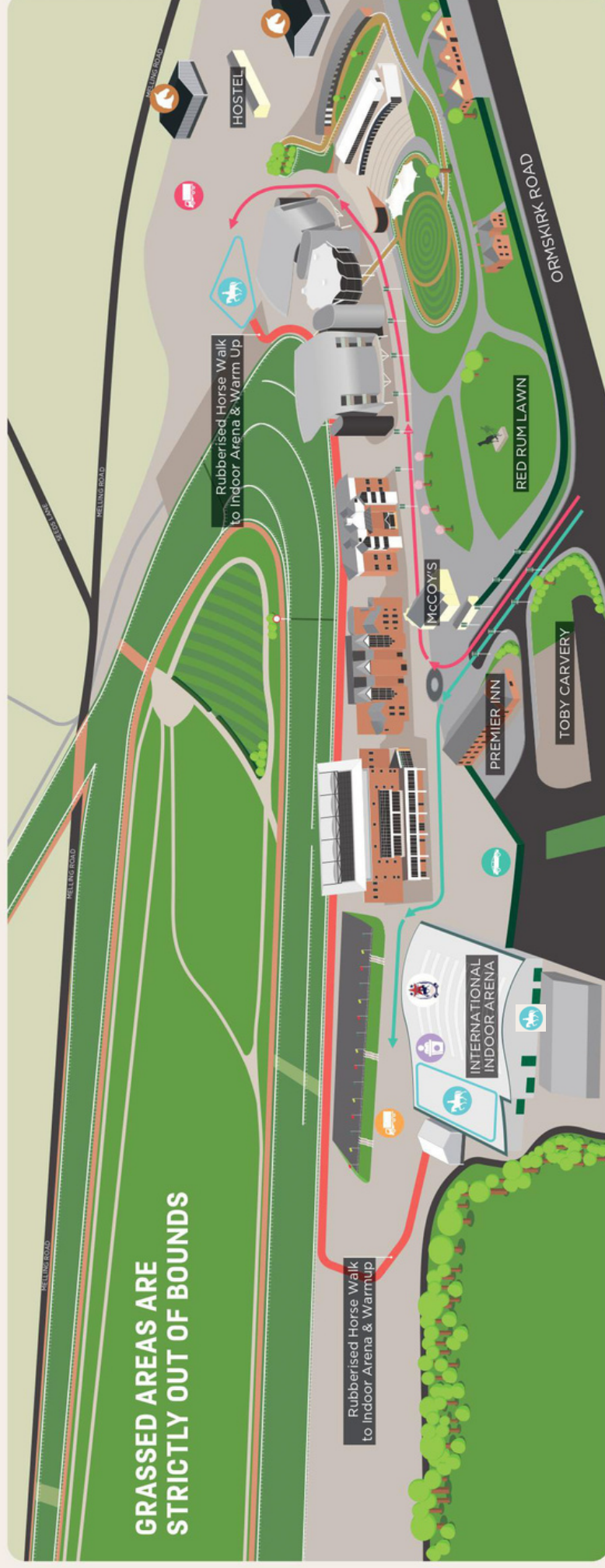

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TRAVELLING TO AINTREE

Postcode - L9 5AS

Aintree Racecourse is located on the A59, just one mile from the M57 and M58, which link the M62 and M6. Follow the A59 to Liverpool and the AA brown racecourse signs as you approach the racecourse.

If you are coming from the M57/M58, please follow Ormskirk Road (A59), past Asda, McDonalds and the Industrial Estate. Please take the left turn at the traffic lights for the racecourse, just after KFC and by The Toby Carvery.

To enter the racecourse, go underneath the barriers and turn **RIGHT** for the stables at the mini roundabout or **LEFT** if you are a day competitor not stabling.

ARRIVAL

DAILY COMPETITORS (NOT STABLING)

Daily horseboxes will be parked adjacent to the Equestrian Centre and an overflow lorry park will be alongside the racecourse track. All parking is on tarmac or hard standing.

Gates will open at 7.00am each competition day, and no earlier.

STABLING COMPETITORS

When you have arrived at the racecourse, drive straight past the grandstands with the Parade Ring on your right. You will then drive up a slight incline, next to the outdoor arena, and you then turn right for the stables.

The stable manager's office is located next to the gates into the main stable yard. There will be stables signage in place and parking stewards to guide you.

STABLES

- The parking stewards will direct you on where to park when you arrive. Please follow their guidance when parking. There will be busy periods, so we do ask that you are patient with them and follow their instructions on where to park.
- Arrival times are **2pm – 7.30pm**. You must vacate your stable by 8am on Monday morning.
- The latest time you can arrive on site for stabling is 7.30pm.
- If you feel you cannot make these times, you will need to email us for prior permission. info@aintreeequestriancentre.co.uk so that we can inform security

Vaccination policy if stabling

As per our terms and conditions, all horses STABLING at Aintree EC must have had a booster vaccination against Equine Influenza in the **PRECEDING 6 MONTHS**, and be 6 days clear of having had any vaccination.

The last vaccination must have been between the **30th March 2025 and 24th September 2025**

ALL PASSPORTS WILL BE CHECKED ON ARRIVAL. Horses will not be permitted to stable at Aintree if they do not have the correct vaccinations

PASSPORTS WILL BE CHECKED ON ARRIVAL

- A **£30 stable cash deposit** will be required when you arrive. This is to be paid at the Stable Managers office.
- All stables must be **fully emptied** before you leave. Stables will then be checked and the £30 deposit will be refunded back to you when you leave. There is no choice in emptying, they must be fully emptied as we have a tight turnaround for another show arriving when you leave.
- Bags will be provided from the stable office to take shavings home.
- Please ensure you unload as quickly as possible, due to large numbers arriving, we need you to unload your horse and then unload other equipment once you are parked up.
- We do have some **tack/storage lockers** near the permanent stables which are available to use, these are £5 cash each to hire, and they are on a first come, first served basis. A £5 cash key deposit will also be required which will be refundable on return.
- All stables will have two bales of bedding when you arrive. The bedding is either paper or shavings.
- Please ensure you bring your own feed. There is no feed store at Aintree.
- Hay and Haylage is available to pre book through Horse Monkey before the show starts. Please ensure you pre book to ensure we have enough.
- No mucking out equipment or wheelbarrows will be available, please ensure you bring your own.
- Please provide your own water and feed buckets.
- Strictly **NO SMOKING** in the stable complex or in any building on site.
- The solarium will only be open in the winter months.
- The route to the Equestrian Centre from the stables is along the rubberised walkway in front of the grandstands along the side of the racecourse. Passing places will be put in place along this walkway. All horses **MUST** use this route at all times and not use the back of the Grandstands or the tarmacked area.
- The Equestrian Centre is about a 10 minute walk from the stables, so ensure you allow plenty of time for your journey before your class.
- The stables have a 24 hour manager on site and they will be located in the Stable Manager's Office by the entrance to the stables.

- The stables will be closed at 11.00pm at night and the Stable Manager will do regular walk rounds during the night. We request that competitors avoid going into the yard after this time to allow the horses to settle and rest. The stables will be back open at 6am but we request that the noise is kept low due to local residents who are overlooking the stable yards.
- Strictly no dogs in the stable yards at any time. This is a BHA rule and must be adhered to at all times
- There is free tea and coffee for grooms in the tea room in the brick stable yard. Please bring a cup to help reduce plastic waste.

HOOK UPS & ACCOMODATION

- **Hook ups** are available to purchase through HorseMonkey.
- Please advise the Stable Manager when you arrive that you have booked a hook up and you will be directed to the hook up steward.
- Those who have booked hook ups, will need to bring their own adapters. Aintree do not provide any adapters or leads.
- Please ensure that your hook up equipment is in full working order. The electricity supply at Aintree is checked regularly and is in full working order. If your hook up equipment does not work or trips the supply, we may not be able to give you this service.
- If you are a non-hook up, you will be directed to park away from the hook up lorries
- The stable manager will issue keys for the hostel accommodation when you arrive. Please bring a £10 cash deposit for your room keys.
- There are bins located around the stable yard and also in the lorry park. Please ensure that you help keep Aintree tidy. We are renowned for having a tidy racecourse and like to keep it that way!

FLU VACCINATIONS

All horses must be fully up to date with flu vaccinations

Vaccination policy if stabling

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The last vaccination must have been between the **30th March 2025 and 24th September 2025**

ALL PASSPORTS WILL BE CHECKED ON ARRIVAL. Horses will not be permitted to stable at Aintree if they do not have the correct vaccinations

Vaccination policy if competing

All horses ATTENDING BUT NOT STABLING at Aintree EC must have had a booster vaccination against Equine Influenza in the PRECEDING 12 MONTHS, and be 6 days clear of having had any vaccination. PLEASE HAVE YOUR PASSPORT AVAILABLE FOR CHECKING.

SHOWERS

Showers are located in the Hostel, by the stables

- The shower facilities are only available to those who do not have showers in their lorry.
- There will be showers available each day in the hostel, located next to the permanent stable yard.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- The showers will be cleaned regularly during the day, but if you feel they need a clean, please let the stable manager know.

TOILETS

- There are toilets located in both stable yards, the hostel and in the Equestrian Centre.
- All toilets will be cleaned and disinfected regularly throughout the show
- If you are not happy with the cleanliness of the toilets, please inform the cleaner or member of staff as soon as possible.
- Please respect our toilet facilities and leave them how you expect to find them. Please flush the toilet!

DOGS

- Due to BHA rules, dogs must not enter the stabling area.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. No exception to the rules.
- We ask that all dogs are cleaned up after they foul. This is an increasing problem at Aintree and people will be asked to leave if they are seen not to adhere to this rule and dogs will no longer be allowed to come on site.
- We request that dogs are kept out of the café and eating areas, as well as off the furniture in the Owners and Riders lounge.
- Please keep your dogs away from Tradestands, we have had many complaints about them fouling near the stands.
- Dogs are not permitted on the racecourse track at any time.
- If your dog fouls or urinates in the arena, it must be cleaned up immediately.
- THERE IS A ZERO TOLLERANCE TO DOGS FOULING AND NOT BEING CLEANED UP. IF YOU ARE CAUGHT, YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW.

KEEP BELONGINGS LOCKED AWAY

- There have been some recent thefts at other venues, so please ensure you leave all belongings locked away at all times.
- It is your responsibility to look after your belongings and keep vehicles locked at all times.
- Please report any suspicious behaviour to a member of staff.



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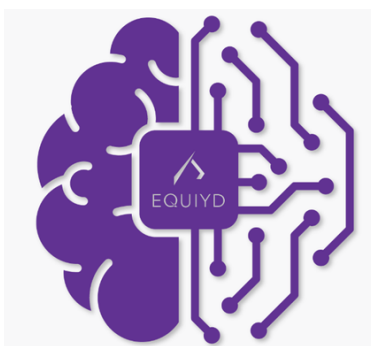


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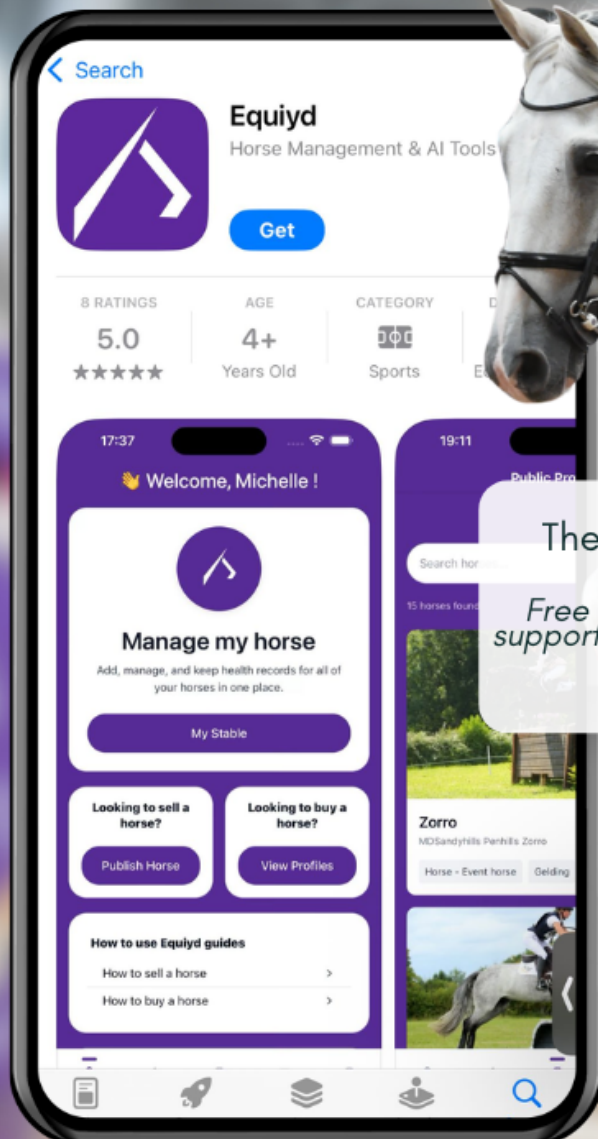

ENTRIES

Wednesday's entries need to be made by 3pm on Monday, to allow the times to be released within the 36 hour rule. Entries for other days will close at 4pm the day before.

BIKES AND SCOOTERS

- Bikes are permitted, but please ride them responsibly. Aintree is classed as a public highway when the gates are open.
- Electric scooters are **not** permitted on public highways, so therefore are not permitted to be used around the racecourse.
- Licensed Disable scooters are permitted.
- There is a 5mph speed limit around the racecourse at all times.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

WARM UP ARENAS

Aintree has three warm up arenas

- The outdoor arena by the stables is available to use all day. Maximum 6 horses/riders at once.
- The walkway down to the arena is a crucial part of your warm up before you get to the arena. This is strictly walking only. A nice leg stretch down there and also great for cooling down after you compete.
- The outdoor at the back of the arena will be available for those in the next 1/2 hour to compete. A maximum of 8 horses/riders at once.
- The indoor warm up is available for the next class to compete in the main arena.
- There are a lot of arenas and we would really appreciate help with poo picking too, so please bear this in mind to help keep our surfaces at their very best.
- Please, if you are asked to come out of the arena, try not to be rude to our staff member as we do need to stick to the strict rules.
- Lunging is not permitted.

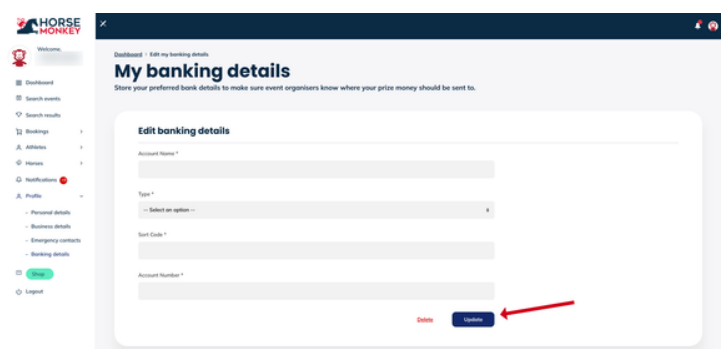
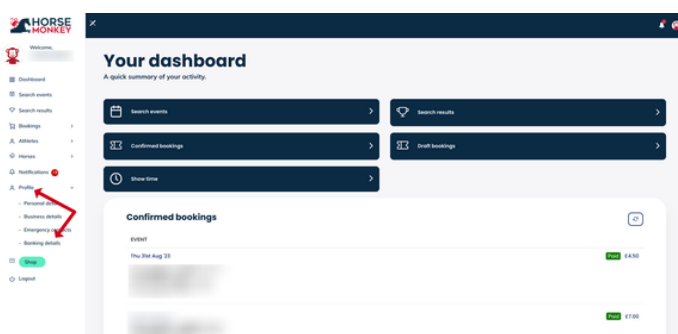
COURSE WALKING

- There will be a course walk at the beginning of each jumping class.
- Course walk timings will be detailed with the drawn orders on HorseMonkey from Tuesday afternoon
- The first 8 horses to jump will be permitted to be held in the indoor warm up.
- Horses 9-15 to jump can be held in the outdoor warm up and there's a door into the main arena for easy access.
- Anyone else will be asked to hold horses outside of the arena.

PRIZE MONEY

NEW PROCESS FOR PRIZE MONEY

- Anyone that wins prize money at Aintree International Equestrian Centre needs to update their bank details on their HorseMonkey profile.
- This information will then be used to transfer the prize money to their bank account.
- Please note: It is the competitor's responsibility to provide bank details in order to be paid prize money. **Bank details must be provided via HorseMonkey within 7 days of the event, otherwise prize money will be forfeited.**



ORDERS AND TIMINGS

- Orders and times will be sent to you via Horse Monkey or can be accessed via the link below when they have been published.

- The drawn orders for the other days will be on the website, no earlier than 4pm the day before.
- Drawn orders will also be displayed on our website throughout the show.
- Timings will be detailed for each class on the drawn orders.
- Declarations are required with the collecting ring steward before the class commences.

GRAZING

- There is a small grazing area in the stable yard.
- When grazing, please use a bridle, chifney and lunge line to reduce the risk of having loose horses!
- Please DO NOT graze horses on the racecourse track as this is sprayed frequently.

CATERING AND REFRESHMENTS

- The Tophams cafe overlooking the warm up area will be open throughout the show.
- Further seating and tables will be available in the arena.
- The Cafe will be open 7.30am until 2.30pm.
- Catering units in the arena will be open from 11am until late.
- The Cafe is card only.
- There will be a bar open in the arena.

ATMOSPHERE

- Audience participation is encouraged at this show.
- Clapping and cheering is encouraged.
- Please support your fellow competitors.
- Background music will be played as well as lap of honour music.
