Adult riders not wearing a safety hat do so at their own risk **and must sign a disclaimer** at the time of collecting their competitors' number **prior to competing.**

Juniors' riders (aged 18yrs and under) **must wear a hard hat** that complies with current British Safety Standard or above at all times. Hard hats to current British Safety Standard or above **must be worn in any Jumping class.**

The winner will receive the **'Copper Caprice Trophy' Rosettes and Prizes in kind to all competitors.**

Entry Fee: £16.50

This class will be judged on horseback at walk. The Judge may then inspect competitors' attire and horse/pony's tack closely, for historical accuracy. Competitors are required to submit a resumé and photograph of their costume with their entry form, to confirm authenticity, which will be referred to by the Judge and Commentator. Resumé and photograph must not exceed one A4 size sheet of paper and be clearly marked with the Competitor's name.

Class 8. Foundation Walk and Trot Freestyle Equitation

Open to riders aged 12 years and under (Members and Non-Members)

Judge: Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the **'Benison Trophy' Rosettes to sixth place. Prizes in kind to all competitors.**

Entry Fee: £16.50

This class is open to Lead Rein and Non-Lead Rein Junior riders who have not attained their 13th birthday on the 1st January of the current year's show. Competitors will walk only in the go-round. Each competitor will be asked to give a freestyle show **not exceeding 2 minutes**. Cantering is **not permitted** for this class.

Class 9. Junior Side Saddle Concours d' Elegance

Kindly sponsored by The Bevan Family

Open to Junior Riders aged 17 years and under (Members and Non-Members)

Judge: Miss Henrietta Barton (Leicestershire)

The winner will receive the ***'Bevan Family' Sash. Rosettes to sixth place.***

Entry Fee: £16.50

This class is open to Juniors who have not attained their 18th birthday on the 1st January of the current year's show. The sole criteria for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance, but detailed inspection of rider or tack is not required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the Judge may ask groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest Junior Member of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards.

Class 10. The Conspiracy Theory - Adult Side Saddle Concours d' Elegance

Kindly sponsored by Mrs Rosamund Lane and Mrs Sophie Lane-Keery –

In memory of dearest Super-Ted (Members and Non-Members)

Judge: Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the ***'Conspiracy Theory' Sash. Rosettes to sixth place.***

Entry Fee: £16.50

The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance, but detailed inspection of rider or tack is not required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the Judge may ask groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult Member of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards. N.B. Silk hats are permitted to be worn by adults in this class AT ANY TIME OF DAY.

Class 11. The 'Senior' Side Saddle Gracious Ladies 'Horsemanship' Class Kindly sponsored by The Senior Family

Section 11a Open to Adult Riders aged 40 - 60 years (Members and Non-Members)

Section 11b Open to Adult Riders aged 61 years and over (Members and Non-Members)

Judge: Miss Henrietta Barton (Leicestershire)

The winner of each section will receive the ***'Senior Family Trophy' Rosettes to sixth place.***

Mementos to all competitors. The 'Senior International Side Saddle Award' will be presented to all Gracious Ladies aged 70yrs and over. (Please state eligibility on the entry form)

Entry Fee: £16.50

Competitors are required to walk and trot only in the go-round followed by a two-minute freestyle show which may include canter if wished. To be judged on horsemanship skill, gracious style, and performance.

Class 12. Mixed Native Breeds Class Kindly sponsored by Miss K. Ettritch

Section 12a: Open to Lead Rein and Non-Lead Rein Junior riders, 10 years and under. (Members and Non-Members)

Competitors are required to walk and trot in the go-round followed by a two-minute freestyle show. No cantering allowed.

Section 12b: Open to Adult and Junior Riders 11 years and over. (Members and Non-Members)

Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter in the go-round followed by a two-minute freestyle show.

Please note: Competitors entering section 12a are not allowed to enter section 12b.

Judge: Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner of each section will receive the ***'Ettritch Trophy' Rosettes to sixth place.***

Entry Fee: £16.50

This class is open to Mountain and Moorland type horse/ponies, pure and part bred. Exhibits will not be stripped.

Class 13. Family Horse or Pony

Kindly sponsored by Newclose Properties

Open to Adult and Junior Riders (Members and Non-Members)

Judge: Miss Henrietta Barton (Leicestershire)

The winner will receive the '**Newclose Properties Trophy**' Rosettes to sixth place.

Entry Fee: £16.50

Entrants will consist of **one Adult and one Junior rider, at least one of whom will ride side saddle**. The Adults will enter the arena on their horse/pony together for the initial judging which will include walk, trot, and canter in the go-round, after which the Junior will give a **two-minute maximum freestyle show**. The Junior must be of a suitable size and competence to control their horse/pony. Riders may ride more than one horse in this class. Competitors are not required to jump.

Class 14. Best Coloured Horse or Pony Kindly sponsored by Mr R. Oultram and Mrs S. Oultram

Open to Adult and Junior Riders (Members and Non-Members)

Judge: Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the '**Oultram Trophy**' Rosettes to sixth place.

Entry Fee: £16.50

This class is open to all coloured horses and ponies. (Appaloosa, Dun, Palomino, Piebald or Skewbald, Roan, Cremello and such like coloured) Exhibits will not be stripped. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter in the go-round followed by a two-minute freestyle show.

Please note: Time will be allowed for competitors to change from their Costume Class to Habits and Vice-Versa

Class 15. Historical Side Saddle Class - Vintage Habits 1840 to 1899

Kindly sponsored by Mrs S. Fernside

Open to Adult and Junior Riders (including Lead Rein) (Members and Non-Members)

Judges: Miss Henrietta Barton (Leicestershire) and Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the '**Othello Trophy**' Rosettes and Prizes in kind to all competitors.

Entry Fee £11.50 This class will be judged on horseback at walk. The Judge may then inspect competitors' attire and horse/pony's tack closely, for historical accuracy. Competitors are required to submit a resumé and photograph of their costume with their entry form, to confirm authenticity, which will be referred to by the Judge and Commentator. Resumé and photograph must not exceed one A 4 size sheet of paper and be clearly marked with the Competitor's name.

Class 16. The Side Saddle Association Contemporary Ladies Side Saddle Qualifier

Kindly sponsored by Dr Karen Milbourne

Judge: Miss Henrietta Barton (Leicestershire)

The winner will receive the '**The Out and About Trophy**' Rosettes to sixth place.

Entry Fee: £16.50 Open to SSA Adult and Junior Members and Non-members riding a Native, Part Bred, Heavy or World Breed horse / pony side saddle. **To be judged 25% suitability of horse/pony for rider, 25% manners and way of going for type, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider**. Conformation will not be taken into consideration. The Judge will request a short show. Traditional habits must be worn. N.B. Silk hats are permitted to be worn in this class **at any time of the day**. Judges are requested to use the mark sheet provided. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. One special rosette and the qualification card will be given to the qualifying combination at each show, this may not always be the winner; if the winner has already qualified, they may be passed down to fourth place. Qualifiers kindly sponsored by **The Langley Family**. Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the SSA **21 days prior to the**

National Side Saddle Show or as soon as possible if qualified after that date to be eligible to compete at the Final. Combinations qualifying between one National Side Saddle Show and the next may carry forward the qualification, for that year only. Please note: You may only enter either the Classical or Contemporary class and only qualify for one of the finals unless you have two horses/ponies of a different type.

Class 17. The Tessa Mitchell Classical Ladies Side Saddle Qualifier

Kindly sponsored by Mrs T. Mitchell and Mr L. Mitchell

Judge: Mrs FranPenn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the '**Mitchell Trophy and Sash**' Rosettes to sixth place.

Entry Fee: £16.50

Open to SSA Adult Members and Non-Members, aged 18 and over on January 1st of the current year, riding side saddle, on horses exceeding 148cm (14.2hh). **To be judged 25% conformation and action, 25% manners & way of going, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider, by a SHBGB, BSHA or SSA Panel Judge.** Judges may request a short show but will not ride exhibits; horses will not be stripped.

Traditional habits must be worn. Fancy Dress and Period Costumes **not permitted**. NB Silks Hats are permitted to be worn in this class **at any time of the day**. Judges must use the mark sheet provided. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. One special rosette and the qualification card will be given to the qualifying combination at each show, this may not always be the winner, if the winner has already qualified they may be passed down to fourth place. In the event of previous qualification, this may be passed down to fourth place. Qualifiers kindly sponsored by Mrs T Mitchell and Mr L Mitchell. Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the SSA **21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show** or as soon as possible if qualified after that date to be eligible to compete at the Final. Combinations qualifying between one National Side Saddle Show and the next may carry forward the qualification, for that year only.

The four highest placed **Riding Horse, Hack** (not ex 160cm), **Cob or Hunter**, Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over, ridden by a SSA Adult Member qualify for the current year's **BSHA Championship Show Mears Ladies Show Horse Championship** and if already qualified the ticket will go to the highest placed horse down to 5th place. Combinations qualifying after the current year's BSHA Championship Show may carry forward the qualification, to the following year. **SSA Members** who qualify for **The Mears Ladies Show Horse Championship, will not be required to join the BSHA** in order to compete in any **Side Saddle class** at the **BSHA National Championship Show**. If the BSHA Championship Show entries have closed at the time of qualification, competitors will not be charged a late entry fee for the **Championship**.

NB: Competitors may only enter either the Contemporary (Class 16) or Classical (Class 17) class (not both) unless you have two horse/ponies of a different type.

Class 18. Masters 'Prix d' Excellence' Equitation Class (This is the first element of a two-part competition)

Kindly sponsored by Mr S. Marchbank and Mrs C. Marchbank

Open to Adult and Junior Riders. (Members and Non-Members)

Judges: Miss Henrietta Barton (Leicestershire) and Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

Entry fee: £17.50

Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter in the go-round followed by a **two-minute maximum freestyle show**. To be judged on effective horsemanship. Suppleness, straightness, and position of the rider. Manners of the horse and way of going.

Masters 'Prix d' Excellence' Jumping (This is the second element of a two-part competition)

Choose your own height of course, maximum height: 60cms (2'0") 70cms (2'3") 76cms (2'6"). Heights must be declared at time of entry, on the entry form. To be judged on effective horsemanship, suppleness, straightness and position maintained throughout all elements of each jump, i.e., the approach, take off, flight, landing and get away. The results from Section A and Section B will be collated together and the **top six riders** will go forward to the **Masters 'Prix d' Excellence Ride off**

The winner will receive the '**Marchbank Masters Cup**'-**Prix d'Excellence Rosettes to sixth place. Mementos to all competitors.**

Class 19. Aintree Jumping Challenge

Kindly sponsored by AAA Road Rescue (Leyland)

Open to Adult and Junior Riders (Members and Non-Members)

Judges: Miss Henrietta Barton (Leicestershire) and Mrs Fran Penn (Warwickshire)

The winner will receive the ***'AAA Road Rescue Trophy' Rosettes to sixth place.***

Entry Fee: £17.50

Choose your height of course, maximum heights: 60cms (2'0") 70cms (2'3") 76cms (2'6") 84cms (2'9") 1m (3'3") Heights must be declared at time of entry, on the entry form. The course will consist of ***eight fences.*** Fences 4-8 will be timed against the clock and the fastest clear will determine the winner. In the event of no clear rounds the lowest fault in the fastest time will win.

On foot competitions, no horse required!

Class 20. Vintage Habits with Vintage Accessories (1900 - 1940's)

Entry Fee: £11.50

No costume or replica habits. Judging will take place in the hospitality area at the ring side. Competitors will be asked to show their habits in a cat-walk style parade. To be judged on historical correctness and overall appearance. Competitors are required to submit a resumé of their habits with their entry form, which will be referred to by the Judge and Commentator. Resumé must not exceed one A 4 size sheet of paper and be clearly marked with the Competitor's name.
